Believe Jesus to live forever. My name is Michael and I have heard God speaking to me for years. I grew up near Canton, Ohio without a Holy Bible KJV in the home. I got saved while working at the Pizza Hut in North Canton, Ohio when I was about 20 years old because a guy I worked with actually had a Holy Bible with him to show me Romans chapter 1 and at that point I realized "God really did create us." I started reading the Holy Bible seriously when I was about 27 and then prayed to receive the Holy Ghost and it happened like a week later. It felt like power was flying through my body and energy was coming out of my hands. Later I got baptized and started evangelizing and after years of attempting to preach the gospel to everyone everywhere I began to hear God speaking to me. In 2019, I walked from Florida to Ohio preaching the gospel to just about everyone I met and I gave out Holy Bible KJV's from the Dollar Tree stores that I found along the way. It took four months and 7 days to walk from Jacksonville, Florida to Uniontown, Ohio where I grew up and that year I gave out around 781 Holy Bible KJV's which are the only ones I recommend. I've been living in Lake City, Florida for about 3 years and my church is called Faith Baptist and it's next to the Home Depot here in Lake City, FL. I've been living in a tent for about 10 years and I've been telling people about Jesus with a sealed white Holy Bible KJV from the Dollar Tree in my right hand and an unsealed black one in my left Wrangler cargo pants pocket. I've been going up to people and telling them something like "As long as you believe in Jesus, you'll have eternal life." Then I've usually been mentioning how Holy Bible KJV's have been at the Dollar Tree stores to where you could buy them and give them out for free, Lord willing. I've usually then mentioned that I walked from Florida to Ohio giving them out and after some brief preaching of the importance of doing exactly what Jesus commanded I've then reached into my upper left pocket and pulled out a small coin collection I've been working on and while showing that I've asked, "Would you be willing to spare some change, it could help me with my ministry?" Sometimes when they seemed to not really have much to give, I mentioned that some people have gone to the ATM to help me if they would like to do that and sometimes they have but it's been pretty rare. As I've been going out and trying to tell people the good news about how Jesus died for us

and was raised to life and if you believe in Him you'll have eternal life I ended up meeting people who claimed to be people from The Holy Bible KJV. I can't prove it yet if it was really them but I thought I'd at least mention it since the whole experience of meeting these people was pretty amazing. The list of people I met who claimed to be from the Holy Bible is as follows: The first told me he was "Saul of Tarsus" who's also the apostle Paul and he had it written in the Holy Bible something like we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord would not prevent them that have fallen asleep and so to me that means that he believed that he would be alive until the coming of the Lord which is referring to the second coming of Christ. The second person said he was "Lazarus" whom Jesus raised from the dead and he told me he saw Jesus on the cross and he also saw Christ after His resurrection. The third person was "Peter" one of the twelve disciples of Jesus and when I asked him if he was Peter from the Holy Bible he said something like, "Yeah, that tells you about my family history." The fourth was "King David" who told me his son Solomon was so rich that he was like a trillionaire compared to the billionaires of today and when I asked him about his childhood friend named Jonathan from the Holy Bible he said something like, "What do you mean my friend Nathan? Nathan is the one that rebuked me for my sin against Bathsheba." which you can read about in the Old Testament. "King David" also had a pocket watch attached to a chain necklace that he wore and he told me that back in the day these things were like iPhones in popularity. The fifth was "Joshua" from the book of Joshua and when I asked him if he was from the Holy Bible he said something like, "Yeah, took down some pretty strong walls, right?" which was basically him saying that he was the same Joshua who marched around the city of Jericho as it is written to where God caused the city's walls to collapse so the Israelites could take over the city. The sixth was "Andrew" one of the twelve disciples of Jesus and Peter's brother and when I asked him if he was from the Holy Bible he said something like, "Yeah, and I don't do autographs." After telling this story so many times I even met somebody else who said they met the same person claiming to be Peter in the same city where I found him. This reminded me that Jesus did say something like whosoever lives and believes in Him would never die so I really do believe that those people who I got to meet could have

actually been who they said they were. In the book of Matthew it mentions that when Jesus was crucified there were saints that came out of their graves who later went and appeared unto many after His resurrection which to me explains how I may have met King David and Joshua since they're from the Old Testament. I think sometime after I met these people I eventually heard God say to me audibly "Michael Rivalsky has a beautiful idea." It seemed like He was saying it not only to me but also to everybody in heaven so I said, "Jesus, you have the best ideas." and I heard Him say "I do have the best ideas." Since then anytime I said to Him that same thing He would say the same thing back to me. His voice really does sound like the still small voice I heard about and He's usually sounded like He was talking from over the horizon where I could just barely hear Him. He has spoken to me daily for years now and I am so thankful for how He has helped me survive all the trials and tribulations it took for me to get this far. I'd like to also mention that Jesus has been doing something that He promised He would do if a person would go out and confess Him before men and that is that He would confess that person before the Father and the holy angels. So He actually started doing that and I don't know if anybody else has ever had this experience like me. Also, I asked God how long it would be until the "mark of the beast" mentioned in the book of Revelation and He told me around February of 2019 while I was walking to Ohio from Florida that it would be 127 years from then. There's more I could tell you about, Lord willing, but I hope you'll remember that we're supposed to be preaching the gospel to every creature everywhere we go and the Dollar Tree has had Holy Bible KJV's that you could give out for free and let others know about as well, Lord willing.
