

Hello Parents,

Thank you all for a wonderful first year here at St. Brigid of Kildare! It has been a pleasure getting to know you and care for your children. Summer is a great time for yearly check ups and I would like to remind parents to please update the clinic of any health changes. Examples include new medical diagnoses, starting a new medication or receiving new immunizations. All students entering 7th grade will have to submit 7th grade immunizations if they have not done so already.

If you have a new student starting in the fall, we require the following forms for each student:

Health History Form
Physical Examination & Immunization Form
Oral Assessment (optional)

You can find the forms on our website [here](#). The forms are not due until the 14th day of school, but I like to send them out in case you go to your child's pediatrician this summer.

We try to limit the amount of medication taken at school, but know that there are times when it is necessary. If your child takes a prescription medication, please have their physician fill out [this form](#) and I will collect medications at the beginning of the school year. The medication must be in its original container from the pharmacy. These forms must be filled out and updated each school year.

If your child does have a health diagnosis or medical condition, I would like to meet with you and your child in August before school starts so that we may establish or update an individual health plan for your child. Please reach out to me via phone or email so that we may set up a time to meet. If your child has asthma or a food allergy, there are also [forms](#) that will need to be filled out by your child's physician. These forms and seizure action plans must be filled out and updated each school year.

You may email, fax, or drop off forms.
