“Positive” Comment: Good choice of resource site- elegant, modern

“Need to Work on” Comment: Not a fan of the wireframe layout- needs more spacing

2. Anna R.

“Positive” Comment: I love the nav bar that you decided to choose its clean and simple.

“Need to Work on” Comment: Making a clearer design layout because she is using two websites and is taking different things from different websites

“How they Helped me” Comment:

I was not sure what to do with the color scheme and emily helped me pick and refine colors. Emily also helped me pick which parts of the resource page I should use because I had two that I liked certain parts of, but not the whole thing.
