The two common types of ID badges used for time clocking are listed below:

Instead, employees just need to bring them close to the card reader, and they will transmit the data, eliminating the need for physical touch between the card and the reader.

**Magnetic Stripe Cards.** Employees need to swipe these cards to share information. The worker with the card has to stop, insert the card, and wait for it to be read. Those seconds build up to minutes, which become lost hours, days, and even weeks over time. Another disadvantage of these cards is that they get demagnetized over time, and the continuous friction of cards being swiped can also cause the readers to wear out faster.

If we compare the above two, prox cards are a more reliable and time-saving solution. When a large number of employees come for a shift at the same time, there may be bottlenecks as employees wait in line to punch in. Workers can get clocked in faster and more efficiently when they use a prox card ID badge as a timekeeping device. They don't have to manually enter digits; in light of Covid concerns, these contactless cards are safer and in demand.
