

# **Chamisa Kellogg Author Visit Information**

Thank you for considering me as a guest author-illustrator at your school or library! It's an honor to share my excitement for books and reading with young readers. An author/illustrator visit from me is typically 45 minutes in length, and consists of three parts: an "About Me" slideshow presentation (sharing my childhood art and inspiration, and my journey to becoming an author and illustrator) a short reading from one of my books, and a look behind the scenes of how a book is made. I usually close by doing a live drawing with suggestions from the students, and take questions from the audience. If time allows, I can also sign books if they have been purchased ahead of time.

I also offer story illustration workshops, which are better suited to smaller groups of students (10-25 students). The workshop takes kids through the basics of visual storytelling, designing a character, and creating a short (1-2 page) illustrated story (I ask that the school/library provide supplies: paper, pencils/erasers, pens). Depending on the age of the group, I can adjust the scope of the project to make the workshop fun and engaging. Workshops can be added to an author visit, or held as a standalone event, and can run at either 45 or 90 minutes.

### **Honorariums**

#### Virtual:

\$250 per 45 minute virtual visit

#### Local:

One 45 minute in person visit (local, Portland) - \$350

Two 45 minute presentations, same location (local, Portland) - \$450

#### Regional (within 150 miles of Portland):

Two 45-60 minute presentations (150 mile radius of Portland) - \$600 + travel

## National:

\$1000/day (up to three 45 minute presentations) plus travel/lodging/meals

45 minute - \$400 90 minutes - \$500 (+ travel/lodging/meals if out of town)
