

SESSIONAL STAFF GRANTS

The WATLF Committee has a limited number of grants available to enable sessional staff across our universities to attend the 2023 WA Teaching and Learning Forum, **University Life: Being, Becoming and Belonging**.

We now invite sessional staff to apply for one of these grants.

What is the grant for?

The grant provides successful winners with single-day registration to the Forum. Registration includes full day attendance to the Forum, catering and attendance to the Belonging Sundowner at the end of the day.

Who is eligible?

Sessional staff at any of the five Western Australian universities who can provide evidence of a 2022 or 2023 contract are eligible.

Conditions/ Criteria

To be considered for this grant, applicants must complete the application template that is available on the Registration section of the WATLF2023 web page. The Template requires:

- A brief list of your core sessional work (e.g. units taught) in 2022
- Justification of your interest in the Forum
- Verification of your sessional staff status from your supervisor
- A copy of university staff ID and 2022 or 2023 sessional contract.

- Submit all documents electronically, including attachments
- Submission after the deadline will not be considered.
