## Agenda/notes

- Scribe: Jonah
- Celina conversation on the interest and capacity of the board to support more defined engagement initiatives.
  - Overall mission for OSGeo Oceania includes more than Australia/NZ
  - OO can enable pandemic recovery (data gaps, employment gaps)
  - Celina is working on funding and community organising with a few groups in the South Pacific
  - \$5,000 OO website budget hasn't led to a high-quality website
  - Alex funding is available but funding hasn't been requested through a proposal.
     Existing website is low/no cost.
  - Edoardo content is the hard part: we can't pay someone to do it, we need to create our own. The job could be managed by breaking it down into smaller parts
  - Greg expenditure requires a funding proposal.
  - Jonah hubs are associated with the FOSS4G Oceania conference; there are other grassroots groups, but not OSGeo Oceania hubs.
  - Edoardo Website design and content: could pay for design improvements and work on the content.
  - Celina need more information about how the community is interacting with OO
  - Ewen would like to see more emphasis on online training and more online events.
     Additional website funding is low-impact.

- Tooa Samoa GIS group isn't aware of funding opportunities. Agree that a website isn't the most valuable means of engagement: social media is more popular.
- Greg funding for initiatives is definitely available, but 5-digit funding packages are unlikely to pass considering OO doesn't have a reliable funding source. Social media is an important comms channel
- Eli there should be a plurality of engagement channels
- Alex OO gets significant income from conferences but we have no recent income.
   Any specific requests?
- ACTION: Celina will put together a proposal to review content on the website.
- ACTION: Celina will review and revise the Communications Strategy
- Alex OO doesn't endorse commercial providers
- Edoardo the comms committee and chair approved the email newsletter that endorsed a commercial provider.
- ACTION: gregory.lauer@gmail.com will call a meeting of the comms working group soon
- 2023 FOSS4G (global) RFP
  - DECISION: Will OO provide a proposal to host the global FOSS4G in Oceania?
    - Motion to provide a proposal did not pass
  - o Eli it would be great to see, especially in Fiji
  - Greg it's a lot of work but Fiji would be great
  - Alex SPC could access funding and institutional support
  - o Eli could delay 2022 conference in lieu of global 2023 conference
  - Jonah GA isn't very excited about this sort of thing
  - Ewen time frame is too short, risk vs reward doesn't add up
  - Alex and Greg effort is better spent on the regional conference
- 2022 conference
  - Resume conversation we started on the mailing list
  - Greg covid will still be an issue. We could add onto the PGRSC conference in Suva (a FOSS4G day managed by OSGeo Oceania)
  - Generally positive reaction to Greg's proposal.
  - ACTION: Jonah Sullivan will write a proposal to PGRSC to have a FOSS4G day during the PGRSC Conference and report the response at the next meeting
