
Fintech app

This is an app businesses can use to manage money, track how much they spend and record the financial goals of the business.



Quickbooks:

QuickBooks is an accounting software package developed and marketed by Intuit. QuickBooks products are geared mainly toward small and medium-sized businesses and offer on-premises accounting applications as well as cloud-based versions that accept business payments, manage and pay bills, and payroll functions. This application does not help the business to budget and record their financial goals.



Financepal: They help small business owners keep their finances on-track. They help as Small companies with accounting, bookkeeping, payrolls, and tax preparation. Finance pal has something similar to what we want to do, but our goal is to also provide a version which is free. We plan to create a plan whereby customers can have different types of subscriptions. ZarMoney is a cloud-based comprehensive accounting solution for businesses of all sizes. It offers various features such as inventory management, billing and invoicing, automated accounting controls, text and email alerts, a customizable dashboard, advanced user permissions, and report creation. They do not have a section that analyzes sales. Our application will have that. The service they provide is similar to what we want to do but our user interface will look different.



According to a study conducted by wepay, around 70% of small businesses do not have an accountant, and more than half of those businesses rely entirely on their owner or manager to handle their finances. The rest (just shy of 30% overall) have one or more employees who are responsible for finances and accounting (wepay 2019).

PCMag reported that according to the US Business of Bureau Index, 20% of Small Business Enterprises without accounting software struggle to last in their 1st year. Here is the summary of the results obtained from the survey:
