## Course Description

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This asynchronous summer course empowers students to confidently navigate the digital world by utilizing Google Applied Digital Skills. Through engaging video lessons, interactive activities, and real-world projects, students will build essential skills for success in both their personal and academic lives. - **Essential Life Skills:** Develop critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, presentation, and decision-making skills applicable to all aspects of life.
