Lesson Synopsis for July 26, 2026:

Today we will be discussing President Emily Belle Freeman's message titled "Best Days and Worst Days". Quotes we will be examining are focused on the idea that mortality is a proving ground. A place designed for growth. The trials we face can be for our benefit and can help us gain attributes such as strength, empathy and patience. President Freeman uses Peter's life as an example about becoming a disciple over time and that spiritual growth includes both success and struggle. Testimony is built over time, day after day, both best days and worst.

Drawing from For the Strength of Youth pamphlet she makes a list of how Jesus Christ has been her strength:

"God's plan is for you. ... He has all power and knows all things. You can trust Him, even when life is hard."

"God wants to communicate with you." He knows you. He knows your name. "Pour out your heart to Him. ... Be still and listen for His answers."

"Jesus Christ will help you. ... When you are worried, afraid, or [struggle] in any way, He will comfort you."

"Walk in God's light. ... You make better choices when you can see things clearly."

"Temple ordinances and covenants give you greater access to God's blessings," help you navigate your life with divine guidance, increase your companionship with the Spirit and with angels, and enable you to live up to your privileges and draw upon the power of God.

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Finally, “Jesus Christ brings joy. ... You might have a bad day, a bad week, or a bad year. [Just remember,] joy is not the absence of sorrow in your life; [it is] the presence of [Jesus] Christ in your life.”

Here is a sample of some questions we will be considering:

- Have you noticed that after an especially trying time, you are stronger than before or closer to God? Did you grow from that experience?
- When did hard times push you to learn new skills? Did you grow?
- What do we learn from the fact that Jesus was in the water with Peter?
- What does Peter’s story teach about the difference between failure and learning discipleship?

President Freeman concludes her message with the following: “Because Jesus Christ knows all about best days and worst days: suffering so great that an angel was sent to strengthen Him, the betrayal of a good friend, the cross on Calvary. But His story also has a garden, a stone rolled away, and an empty tomb. Because of Him no matter how bad things are right now, your best days are ahead. Jesus Christ is our strength.”

The class will then watch a music video inspired by the teachings from President Freeman’s conference message.
