Minutes

The meeting began with a quick update on tax credit balance. The amount has gone down, due to the Opportunity Room expenditures, which was approved last school year. Next, site council received an update on quotes for getting turf in the middle of our campus. This would once again reduce costs, by saving water, manpower, etc. Additionally, it would look nice throughout the school year. Dr. Michael provided quote amounts for turfing the entire section and for doing part turf, part pavers. The turf option is approximately \$25k and the turf-paver combo is approximately \$30k. The council decided the turf-paver option would be a better fit. The paver walkway could be used as a fundraiser by PTO. There is still more exploring to do, and Dr. Michael stated he would bring this item back in subsequent meetings. Another idea to improve our campus is to add a projector and screen in the gym. This would make this facility ideal to host parent nights, assemblies, promotions, etc. Dr. Michael will look into costs and options.

The CIP has been in the works by members of the leadership team (teacher leaders). Upon completion, the site council will review, as this is one of our prescribed duties.

Dr. Michael briefed the council on our current letter grade of a B. He emphasized that growth is what this letter grade is primarily based on. The staff has taken the first steps to make necessary growth to make an A next year.

Mr. Johnston discussed possible video production and stem classroom updates/upgrades in the future. This is due to the challenges both him and Ms. Hall experience in their current classrooms.
