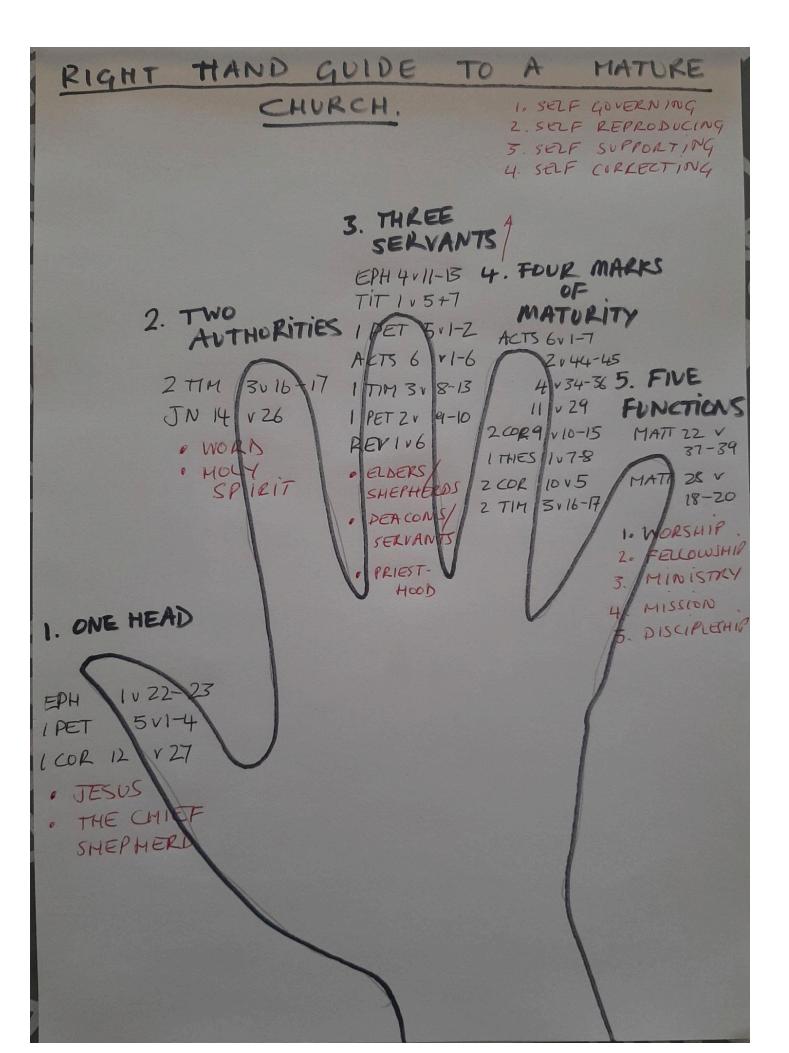
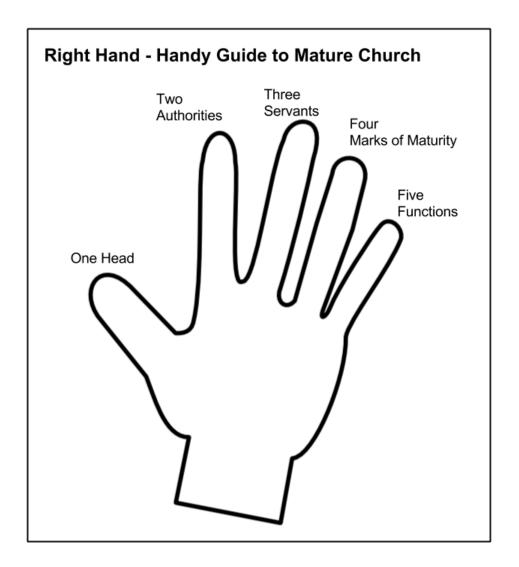
Right Hand Guide to a Mature / Healthy Church - Answers
