



## CONFIRMATION SAINT NAME

During the Catholic Sacrament of Confirmation, God the Holy Spirit comes upon you to bestow numerous spiritual gifts and “confirm” the faith given you in Baptism when Original Sin was wiped away. You choose a Confirmation name before Confirmation. It is suggested that this name be your baptismal name if this is a saint name.

Your Confirmation name, imposed by the bishop during Confirmation, becomes a part of your full name. It comes after your first and middle names and before the last name. The name is to be a Saint’s name that the confirmandi identifies with fitting their personality or spiritual goals. After Confirmation, the confirmed can pray to the Saint for guidance and protection.
