

Digital Train Your Brain!

You may choose from the list below to complete reinforcement activities. Most of the websites will require you to sign in with a google account or create a free account.

1. [Flipsnack](http://www.flipsnack.com)-Digital Flip Book (www.flipsnack.com)
 - a. Cover: include title, block, names, date
 - b. Page 1: include table of contents and introduction
 - c. All pages: must include: text as well as images, videos, and/or music
 - d. Length: Minimum of 8 pages, no more than 16 pages
 - e. All text: must include statements and short paragraphs that summarize and explain major concept(s)

2. [Canva](http://www.canva.com)- **Digital Graphic** (www.canva.com) (There are several choices here!)
 - a. **Documents**- magazine
 - b. **Blogging & eBooks**- album cover, infographic
 - c. **Marketing Materials**- Poster, Flyer, Brochure
 - d. **Events**- Postcard, Invitation, Card
 - e. **Ads**- medium or large
 1. Length: The design must be no more than 2 pages in length
 2. Include: at least **3 paragraphs** to explain **why** the design was selected, how the design explains the concept and why the graphics develop the understanding of the concept.

3. **Concept Mapping**- you are free to search for and use a digital tool that allows the creation of concept or mind maps
When making a concept map, the main theme or concept is the center bubble of the concept map. Related concepts or topics should branch off the center bubble.
 1. Use at least 4 different colors and 4 different shapes on the concept map.
 2. Each color should represent a different thread of ideas or concepts. If a bubble is related to more than one thread of concepts, use the colors to show this.
 3. Each shape of bubble is related to more than one thread of concepts; use all the colors to show this.
 4. Each shape of bubble must represent a different thread of ideas or concepts.
 5. Include a key identifying what each shape and color represents.
 6. An explanation must be written next to the line connecting each set of bubbles.
