1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics, Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability into the Curriculum

SLRTCE strongly believes inculcating values and ethics in students. The cultured and ethical behavior of all faculty and staff members along with traditional campus imparts values and virtues in the students.

Courses such as Project Management and Web Programming etc. help students grow as a professional. These value added courses are introduced as core /elective / exclusive laboratory courses / interdisciplinary courses. University curriculum consists of some subjects to improve professional ethics in students. A subject titled 'Professional Communication and Ethics- I' in first year semester II improves the life skills and professional skills of students. Another subjects named 'Business Communication and Ethics' and 'Environmental Management' help to develop professional and ethical attitude, multidisciplinary approach and awareness about environmental issues.

A subject entitled 'Project Management' in Computer Engineering and Information Technology Department defines tools and techniques for the management of a project plan to monitor and to control a project schedule and budget to track project program.

In addition to curriculum, institute organizes various expert talks, training programs, activities etc. which further support value added courses.
