**Sermon title:**

**Main passage: 1 John 2:28-3:10**

**I. Intro**

- This text is focused on the \_\_\_\_\_ we have in Christ. The outworking of that identity is one who puts off the practice of sinning.
- When the Lord plucked us from death and placed us into life, our identities are not something to discover or figure out, but a firm fixed reality established by \_\_\_\_\_ through Jesus Christ.
- If we are truly transformed we cannot make a \_\_\_\_\_ of sinning. Our identity is firmly fixed in being children of God.

**II. Through Regeneration, your Identity has been remade in Jesus Christ**

- See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called \_\_\_\_\_ of God; and so we are.
- While our identity and our trajectory have been completely \_\_\_\_\_, there is still a not yet fully realized component until Christ's return.
