Dear CHS Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Central High School! Registration for the 2026-27 school year has begun. The initial phase occurred over the past several weeks as academic content area teachers worked to make initial recommendations for English, math, science and social studies courses for each student. Teachers take into consideration student performance in their current course work and review *7th grade GMAS scores* in order to complete these recommendations. **Please also know that 8th grade GMAS scores will be reviewed this summer and will drive final core, honors, and academic course placement. These are only recommendations for placement until final student achievement data is determined for this current academic year. Students must finish this year strong!**

Students have also selected four elective choices to-date, including two alternates; your student will have a total of seven classes on his/her high school schedule.

Please review the academic and elective course selections with your student, make any notes as needed directly on the printout, sign and return to CMS by March 20th.

Please understand that placement in the requested courses is not guaranteed and may be affected by master schedule adjustments, class size, student performance data, and/or schedule conflicts. Rising 9th grade students will receive their schedules during Open House and/or on the first day of school. Students will be allowed to request adding and/or dropping courses during an initial drop/add period which will be offered and communicated by CHS to your student during the first few days of school.

For your review, we have included information about core and elective course offerings that will be available to your student throughout their high school career. We have also included a freshman-specific elective course list, as there are prerequisites for many electives. Thank you for your assistance with the 2026-2027 registration of your student.
