- Students being dropped off in the morning or picked up after school need to enter/exit the school from the high school side of the building. The middle school entrance is to be used by students riding the bus only. For the safety of all of our students, it is important that everyone is following this rule.
- To receive your student's free athletic pass visit the website <https://freelandfalconathletics.bigteams.com/>. Once you are there you will go to the "ticketing" tab along the top. There you will scroll down to the second option that says "2023-24 All Sport Pass". Click "Get Passes". Where it says "Have a Passcode?," you will enter your student ID number. Then proceed to add it to cart and complete the checkout process. There is NO CHARGE for the pass. However, you must complete the checkout process in full in order to receive the pass. If you stop midway through, it will invalidate your code.
