Map download tutorial

A few quick usage tips:

- **Three-lines icon**  is the main menu of the app; some entries are very intuitive, others require a brief explanation:
 - **Download maps.** Map display is always offline, so no network connection is required. Maps can be downloaded in two ways:
 - **Catalog selection:** simply choose the number corresponding to one of our printed maps – this makes it very easy to locate the desired area.
 - **Select on map:** a white frame on the screen allows you to define the area to download. Use one finger to move the background map and two fingers to zoom in. Once the area of interest is within the white frame, confirm the download. Download time depends on your internet connection and the map's size.
 - **Manage maps:** this shows the list of downloaded maps; you can hide (eye icon), view (name), delete (bin icon), or re-download (download icon) them.
 - **My tracks and points:** lists all recorded tracks (phone icon), imported tracks (cloud icon), and points saved by the user.
- **Magnifying glass icon**  has two main functions:
 - Searching for a place name.
 - Creating a route along official trails (in red), then saving it as a .gpx file.

- **Map icon**  :
 - **2D** is the default setting for standard map display.
 - **3D** enables a three-dimensional view of the map, similar to Google Earth. The map can be rotated.
 - **AR (Augmented Reality)** shows place names (cities, mountains, huts, etc.) on the horizon when looking through the phone; this feature is not yet active.

- **Crosshair icon**   :
 - Tap it to switch from white to blue and display the user's current location on the map.

- **Satellite icon**    :
 - Changes color like a traffic light depending on the quality of the GPS signal from visible satellites.

- **Inverted droplet icon**  :
 - Allows the user to save a personal point of interest.

- **REC icon**  :
 - Tap to start recording a track. Tap again to pause or stop recording.

- **Map:**
 - On the main screen, a quick tap on the display hides all the icons. A second tap brings them back.
 - By pressing and holding on a point on the map, you can:
 - add a point of interest
 - view the map in 3D
 - set a destination
 - share that location
