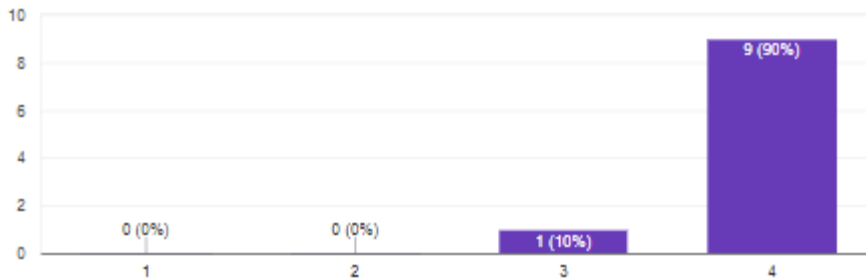

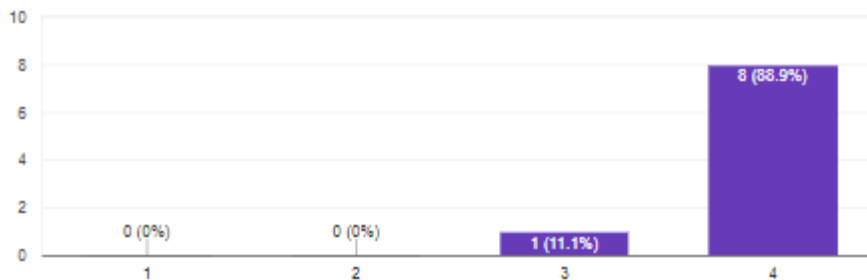

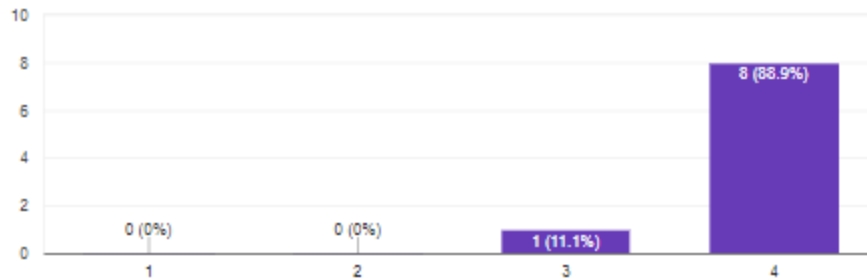

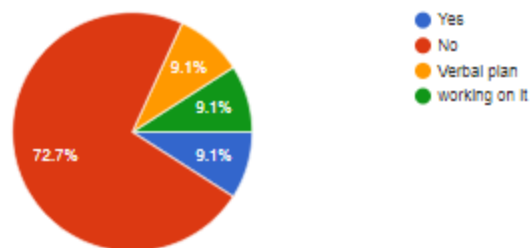


Overall Program 9 responses

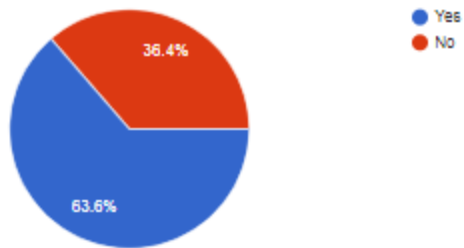
