Results from the 2026 spring Missouri Assessment Program (MAP, EOC, and MAP-A) tests are now available, and we want you to know how proud we are of your children. Our students and teachers have worked hard to reach rigorous academic standards.

High academic standards will prepare Missouri students for success both in school and beyond.

Below you will find information about our most recent state assessments from last spring:

1. **Overall:** Our overall scores in K-12 state tested content areas exceeded the state average. Hollister students scored above the state average or improved from last year's results in 13 of 18 overall tested areas. We are so proud of our students!
2. **In ELA:** Hollister students scored above the state average or improved in 5 of 7 ELA tested areas.
3. **In Math:** Hollister students scored above the state average or improved in 5 of 7 tested areas.
4. **In Science:** Hollister students scored above the state average or improved in 3 of 3 tested areas.
5. **In Social Studies:** Hollister students scored above the state average in 0 of 1 tested areas.

Assessment is one way we ensure we are meeting your child's needs. We use assessments – at the classroom, school, district and state levels – to make critical decisions about instruction, interventions and support, and district policies.

Individual student scores will be distributed to all parents and families during Night of the Tiger (for Elementary School and Middle School, or this year during Q1 parent teacher conferences (High School). If you would like to request your child's score in advance of that time, please contact their building office.
