

Hornet Leadership Board Election/Campaign Rules

2021-2022 School Year (Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior, & Senior Hornet Leadership Board)

1. All candidates must be in good academic standing and be in good disciplinary standing with the Student Center.
2. The Hornet Leadership Board positions: **President /Vice President/Secretary/Treasurer/ 2 Spiritmakers.**
3. In order to run for senior class President, Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer, you must have been a previous class officer during junior, sophomore, or freshman year.
4. A Letter of Intent Google Form will need to be submitted to Mr. Chavarria, the Director of Student Activities. [CLICK HERE FOR THE GOOGLE FORM](#)
5. To have his/her name placed on the ballot, a candidate must submit the completed letter of intent to Mr. Chavarria by September 10th at 3:30 pm.
6. You may only run for *one* Hornet Leadership Board position each academic school year.
7. In lieu of campaign posters, you will create **one** slide in a Google Slides presentation to campaign for your chosen HLB position. Include the Google Slide shared link in the Letter of Intent Google Form. Please include your name, year, and position you are running for in the Google Slide.
8. The term of office of those elected at this election will end in the fourth grading quarter of the school year.
9. Write-in candidates will not be considered.
10. The election will be held on **Thursday, September 16th & Friday, September 17th** (Online voting through Google Form). The voting period will open at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday the 16th and conclude at 3:30 P.M. on Friday the 17th.
