ANZ Future Ferns – Year 1 & 2

Venue;

Introduces Netball to 5 - 6-year olds. The aim is to develop fundamental movement and ball skills.

Fee: \$50 TBC

Ideally we require a parent/caregiver to take the team through some fun/basic fundamental movement and ball skills, (Manual Supplied) at Te Puna School, on an afternoon that suits you.

The other option is to form teams of 4 to play at Tauranga Netball Centre, (TNC), Mt Maunganui on a Saturday, details below. TNC will also accept individual registrations if we don't have a coach at Te Puna, or enough numbers to form teams to attend TNC.

ANZ Future Ferns – Year 3 & 4

Year 6 grading will take place on Saturday 18th May. Years 1-5 don't grade.

START OF FUTURE FERNS COMPETITION

All Future Ferns teams will begin their competition on Saturday 25th May.

Cost; \$55 (Payment will be required as soon as the teams are confirmed by email.)

The focus for this age group is learning basic skills in a modified game of 5-a-side, using two-thirds of a Netball court. MOTHER EARTH future FERNS Year 3 & 4 is designed to be fast and fun, maximising participation. Five players in each team and rotating positions ensures everyone gets an equal chance to develop their skills.

This is played with a 5 vs. 5 format on 2/3 of the court. Game duration 4 x 8 min quarters, 1 mins at each interval and maximum 3 minutes at half time. Rolling substitutions are allowed.

Intermediate –Year 7 & 8

Intermediate Competition

Grading Saturday 18th May. First Game Saturday 25th May

Five (5) weeks of round robin play.

Re-grading between sections. (There will be movement in every grade at the end of the round robin highest in each section will go up and lowest will move down)

Further five (5) weeks of round robin play.

Semi-finals and Finals – Saturday 31st August(Expect time changes)

Game times generally are as follows:

Year 7&8 Start times will be between 8.30am and 9:30am

These times may differ slightly depending on number of teams entered in 2023

Playing time is 4 x 12-minute quarters, 2 minutes at the quarter breaks and the half time break. All timing is controlled by TNC on a central sound.

Year 3 – 8 children (Future Ferns players) will need to wear the school netball uniform for the games. This will be loaned to your child by the school closer to the start of the season. A uniform bond of \$20 must be paid.

* Earrings, studs, taonga's, watches, bracelets, shall not be worn. NO JEWELLERY!! – No Tights or leggings to be worn.

Uniform bond - \$20 in a named envelope to the office. Mrs McGregor will then issue uniforms. The bond will be reimbursed when the dress is returned in excellent condition at the end of the season
