Current Status: Deceased.

Site Director Helen Rayman was killed in service to the foundation upon the detonation of Site 21 alpha warhead. She was killed whilst evacuating lower clearance staff out of the lower administrative levels of the facility.

Executive Researcher Jeremy Rayman:

Like his partner Executive Researcher Rayman was killed during the evacuation of site-21 whilst trying to escort members of his biological hazard defense research team from their secure lab zone. His actions, whilst losing his own life meant that all members of

his staff and their research files were not lost and able to be continued on at the site they were transferred to.

Introduction the the foundation:

Due to the fact that both her parents held senior positions within the foundation they believed that it was worth activating Policy FD90 on Ella, and on 19/8/2020 Miss Rayman was introduced to the foundation by her mother and father.

Ethics Committee Liaison Greenway was also present to the activation.

She also flew through both of the mandatory psychological evaluations and was promptly handed her level 0 clearance.

After gaining her clearance she was able to meet a variety of departmental and divisional leaders due to the position of her parents. The most notable being the Director of Internal Affairs at Site-12, who would later take her under her wing for training.

Training:

Ella Rayman was recruited into the foundation at the request of Director Johnathan Sabus to begin a fast track training program to become an ambassador.

She began her training with an intensive trial period as an agent, during this time she learnt a basic history of the foundation and its duties as well as the ins and outs of the Internal Affairs department. After completing this trial period she was given the promotion to Internal Affairs ambassador.

During her time as an ambassador within site-12 she gained much experience with everything from

targeted surveillance investigations to large scale departmental audits.

Loss of her Parents:

Sadly during the time that Miss Rayman was working as an ambassador both of her parents were killed in service after the detonation of the alpha warhead at site-21 due to a mass breach caused by the actions of hostile GoIs aided by internal defectors.

This event really seemed to trigger something in Miss Rayman. Afterwards she became one of the best ambassadors the foundation had seen finding defectors within the foundation day after day.

After leading a large covert operation her team gave her the nickname “Rose” joking on how she used her unsuspecting appearance to hide how deadly she was to the traitors she was infiltrating.

Promotion to Assistant:

After roughly a year as an ambassador within site-12 Miss Rayman was contacted by the assistant to O5-6 with an offer. A transfer and promotion to Assistant to the council located in Site-65.

She readily accepted and was quickly moved to Pinewood and took up the position.
