Before the Symposium:

- **How can I register for sessions?**
 - Please click on the link in the session description to register on Frontline/MyLearningPlan (MLP). Also, please ensure that you have permission to attend from your district.

 - You will receive a link the day before the session for which you have registered. Please ensure that your name and email address are up to date in Frontline/MLP.
- **Can I share the Zoom link with other colleagues?**
 - Please do not share the Zoom link with other colleagues. Each participant must register for the session on Frontline/MLP.

During the Symposium:

- **Why do I have to ensure that my name is accurate on Zoom?**
