General Healing Prayer Ministry	<i>Issue-Focused Ministry (IFM)</i> <i>from Restoring the Foundations (RTF)</i>
What is it?	What is it?
General in-depth healing prayer ministry is a time for the prayer receiver to spend with 2 trained prayer ministers who are there to compassionately, attentively listen to the concerns of the person in a safe, comfortable environment, and then to pray with him/her about the concerns that brought them for ministry. Prayer ministers are trained to discern the roots of the problems by listening to the Holy Spirit. Then they pray for breakthrough, healing, and restoration. In general, they listen, love and pray.	IFM is an integrated approach to in-depth healing prayer that identifies the root of the issue and addresses generational patterns, ungodly beliefs, deep woundedness, and demonic oppression in a comprehensive and systematic manner. It offers the prayer receiver multiple occasions to hear directly from God with support from trained prayer ministers. All notes taken during ministry are given to the receiver to support “walking out” the insights and healing that occur in the session for continued and lasting freedom. When might I choose this option?	When might I choose this option?
Consider <i>general healing prayer ministry</i> if you: ♦ Have a need to schedule the initial prayer session quickly; ♦ Have a general feeling of dissatisfaction or oppression without knowing why; ♦ Are in a time of crisis or confusion. ♦ Anticipate the need for multiple sessions in order to support you through a challenging situation; ♦ Have trouble hearing from God.	Consider <i>Issue-Focused Ministry</i> if you: ♦ Have an issue or concern that is specific; ♦ Have a desire for healing prayer that is thorough and comprehensive for the issue being addressed; ♦ Have a condition or situation that is part of a generational pattern or has been long-standing; ♦ Realize a need to bring closure to the past so that you can move forward in freedom; ♦ Want healing prayer to prepare for a lifestyle change, such as marriage or a new vocation.

Each prayer minister has been trained and commissioned as a <i>St. James Prayer Minister</i>. Several have had years of experience and advanced training including several healing prayer models. All are committed to confidentiality.	Each prayer minister has been trained and certified in <i>Issue Focused Ministry</i> by <i>Restoring the Foundations</i> authorized trainers in addition to training and commissioning as a <i>St. James Prayer Minister</i>. Several have had years of experience and advanced training. All are committed to confidentiality.
What is the time commitment involved?	What is the time commitment involved?
<u>Application Form</u>: It will take about 10-30 minutes to complete the application checklist. <u>Prayer Session</u>: A typical ministry session takes from 1½ to 2 hours. Multiple sessions may be desirable.	<u>Application Form</u>: The <i>RTF Personal Questionnaire (PQ)</i> has been carefully developed to clarify aspects of the issue to be addressed. It will take at least an hour or so to prayerfully complete it. <u>Prayer Session</u>: A typical ministry session can be completed in about 3 hours, either all at one time or divided into 2 parts.

When completed, it can be emailed to Jane or mailed/delivered to the church office at the address below.	You can apply for ministry by completing the <i>Personal Questionnaire (PQ)</i>. It has been developed by RTF to identify: Generational patterns; Ungodly beliefs about ourselves and others; Areas of deep woundedness; Areas of demonic oppression. It is used to prayerfully guide the planning of the ministry session. PQs are available in the St. James church office or can be obtained by emailing Sandy Blount at sandy.blount.rtf@gmail.com. When completed, it can be emailed to Sandy or mailed/delivered to the church office at the address below.
What if I need additional ministry?	What if I need additional ministry?
Ministry can be on-going. You can schedule additional ministry with the same prayer ministers to have continued prayer and emotional support as needed.	You can schedule ministry for another issue, and can request the same prayer ministers. However, time is usually needed to walk in the newly revealed truths before working on a different issue. Filling out a different PQ focused on the new issue would also be necessary.

The resources used depend on the nature of the reason the receiver is seeking prayer ministry. Each session is led by God the Holy Spirit as the receiver and prayer ministers talk and pray together.	<i>IFM Ministers' and Receivers' Guides</i> developed by RTF are used to ensure consistency in ministry throughout the world. They give the Biblical background, definitions, and ministry steps for each of the ministry components. The use of the guides includes flexibility under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
