Unit 1 Lesson 8



Aim: Students will learn and identify basic school supplies through matching activities while developing fine motor skills and visual recognition.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Real school supplies (crayons, pencils, erasers, scissors, glue sticks)
- Mystery bag
- Large sheets of paper & glue
- Flashcards (crayon, pencil, eraser, scissors, glue stick)
- Student mini flashcards

Tip: Use real-life objects as much as possible to make learning tangible and meaningful. Encourage students to describe how they use each item in their daily school life. Model the activities before you have students do them.

Engage:

Show students the flashcards (crayon, pencil, eraser, scissors, glue stick), name the items and have students repeat after you.

Mystery Bag

Place real objects (crayon, pencil, eraser, scissors, glue stick) inside a bag.

Students take turns reaching inside, feeling an object, and guessing what it is before pulling it out.

As each object is revealed, name it clearly and repeat it together.

Explore & Practice

With the book:

Match & Move

Show the book page and ask students to identify the pictures.

Give each student a small card with one of the school supply names.

They must walk around the room, find the corresponding real object (placed on tables or shelves), and match it to their card.

Then, guide them to complete the worksheet by drawing a line to match the objects to their names.

Closing:

Students can now play a memory game with their mini flashcards of school supplies.

Note: After this lesson, students can do **Fun Book** pages **49-51**.
