Required Check-in Documents on January 25, 2025

Each of the following documents is required and must be presented at check-in on the day of the invitational.

- 1) Final Team Registration (Under Construction)
- 1 per team, please alphabetize team members by last name, requires the coach and principal's signature
- 2) Assumption of Risk Agreement (Under Construction)
- 1 per student, please alphabetize team members by last name, requires student and parent signature
- 3) Sportsmanship Agreement (Under Construction)
- 1 per team, please alphabetize team members by last name, requires students, coach, and principal's signatures

Policies and Information

Per the Texas Science Olympiad rules, each team must be registered with the state to compete in any practice or invitational tournament. If your team(s) status with the state is in question, Anthony Science Olympiad officials reserve the right to request documentation of state registration and payment.

We have room for 36 Teams. We will start a waiting list if needed.

There will be NO concessions. Please plan accordingly.

At Anthony, alternates can only compete if they replace a "regular" (one of the 15) team member. Each team will receive 15 wristbands.

All events will count towards the final team score for the Sweepstakes Trophies.

We do not drop events.

Your best score will count for the Serrpstakes Trophies if you have multiple teams. Student participants are expected to compete in tournament events with an honest effort to follow the rules and the spirit of the competition. The goal of the competition is to give one's best effort while displaying honesty, integrity, and sportsmanship. Students, coaches, parents, and guests are expected to display courtesy and respect toward Science Olympiad officials, other teams, and guests of the Invitational. Failure to show honesty and/or courtesy by a participant, coach, or guest of the team will be penalized by disqualification of the team from that event, the entire tournament, and/or future tournaments.

While not in competition, students are expected to remain in the home camp area under adult supervision. Students should only go to the upper floors to compete in their events. Loitering in the restrooms or stairwells is prohibited. Students should not use the elevator for any reason. If one of your team members requires the use of the elevator due to a medical necessity, please contact Lawrence.witt@cfisd.net at least two days prior to the date of the invitational.

Student participants must be listed on one final team registration and will be required to wear a wristband indicating their team number. If a school fields two teams, students may not cross over from one team to the other. If team members are absent, alternates listed on the final team registration and have assumption of risk and honor code agreements on file, may participate in the tournament. Alternates must participate

throughout the remainder of the tournament. Team members who arrive late and have been replaced by alternates are ineligible to compete. Ineligible students participating in an event will be disqualified from that event. Schools that have ineligible students participating in multiple events will be disqualified from the entire tournament and/or future tournaments.

Medals will be awarded in individual events to teams ranking first through fourth place. Sweepstakes trophies will be awarded to the top four schools. Point totals towards sweepstakes will be calculated from all events. If a school fields two teams, the score for the highest-ranking team from that school will be used to calculate point totals towards sweepstakes.
