 - a. **SWPBIS:** awarded a gold ribbon recognition for SWPBIS - data (evidence) was submitted - sharing the work that is happening at Nimitz
 - i. First SWPBIS meeting on the 30th 9am.
 - b. **PD:** first few weeks have been focused on using data to inform instruction (and create small groups), ELA, history teachers have been working on PDSA cycle, math content is working on performance tasks in preparation for SBA

 - a. **SWPBIS:**
 - i. Dress code during spirit week - Garcia
 - Can we draft a policy that addresses dress code during spirit weeks? (ex: students wear inappropriate bottoms during PJ day or twin day)
 - *Always wear uniform bottoms...? (except for PJs)
 - Students out of uniform, not following spirit week guidelines (bottoms or inappropriate tops) will be sent to the wellness center.* – possible solution - if too many students are out of uniform one day, maybe cancel the next day's spirit event.

- ***all coordinated events should come through ESBMM - wellness organized events & leadership organized events.*
- ii. Mr. Munoz - discipline response for staff / students -
 - Troubleshooting detentions
 - Uniform progressive system is proving effective (only 2 students have reached the stage where detention is necessary).
- iii. How do we “split-up” large groups (during lunch time)?
 - 8-10 students...
 - Students walking around/ gathering in large crowds are of concern - *not students sitting and eating / talking.*

b. Professional development:
