**SUBJECT:** 22-23 CIC 39: Courses reviewed and approved by The General Education, Overlay and Code Subcommittee (GEOC) on 11/18/22 not requiring Senate approval

**PURPOSE:** Information item to the Academic Senate

**ACTION REQUESTED:** That the Academic Senate be informed of the summary list of courses approved by GEOC in one of four categories: I. GEOC recertifications with no revisions, II. GEOC recertifications with non-actionable revisions, III. Non-actionable revisions to GEOC courses, IV. Non-actionable revisions to stand-alone courses (courses with overlays but are not GE courses)

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The General Education, Overlay and Code Subcommittee (GEOC) reviews and approves recertified GE, Overlay or Code courses with no revisions and with non-actionable revisions as well as non-actionable revisions to GE, Overlay or Code certified courses. These GEOC approvals do not require Senate approval, as specified in [19-20 CIC 123](#).

In order to streamline the process, since these GEOC approvals are generally uncontroversial, CIC has changed its procedure and now refers the documents to Senate with a single general designation code (e.g 21-22 CIC 47) with each course listed by a subsidiary designation code (e.g. 21-22 CIC 47-1 through 21-22 CIC 47-1). The designation code, the course numbers, and course names are listed here:
