### JOIN THE ANNUAL UGDSB FRENCH TRIP TO ST DONAT, QUÉBEC!

**International Student Exchange - Ontario**

An exchange trip offers a fantastic opportunity to travel, share cultural differences, broaden your global perspective and improve your language skills!

Improve your language skills during the summer. During the month of July you will travel to Quebec or France where you will stay in the home of your exchange partner. While away, French will be the language of communication. At the end of July, your exchange partner will return to Ontario with you for the month of August.

During the school year you can take part in a 2 month or a 3 month exchange to Quebec or overseas. Participating French-speaking countries include France, Switzerland, and Belgium.

### **KATIMAVIK (ages 17-21)**

#### **Katimavik**



This is a great way to spend “a year off” after high school. Join Katimavik and you will have an experience that combines travel, volunteer work, language study, and personal growth.

Katimavik gives participants the opportunity to participate in an intensive 6 or 9 month volunteer program. As a Katimavik volunteer, you will work for not-for-profit organizations that play an important role in the development of Canadian communities. While on the program, you will live with 10 other young people in two or three different regions of the country. Katimavik allows you to develop your competencies, gain valuable work experience and discover new places while making a difference in communities across Canada.

There are two types of experiences: Classic and Theme

**Katimavik classic** – a 9 month experience that gives you three different placements across the country. One of the placements is in a French speaking community.

**Katimavik Theme** – “Second Language and Cultural Diversity” - a 6 month experience. For three months you are placed in an Anglophone community in western Canada. For the next three months you are placed in a Francophone community in Quebec.

## STUDY IN FRENCH – UNIVERSITÉ D'OTTAWA



Continue your studies and do it as a French immersion student at the University of Ottawa.

Students enrolled in French Immersion study partially in French while earning their undergraduate degree. It is offered in 60 programs in the Humanities, and another 26 programs in the faculties of Science and Engineering offer the Extended French Stream.

French immersion students have access to a wide variety of resources on campus, including a dedicated mentoring centre and French writing help, and numerous opportunities to take French outside the classroom in the National Capital Region and beyond.
