Clean up litter accidents with an enzymatic-based deodorizer. Pick up after your pets on neighborhood walks too!

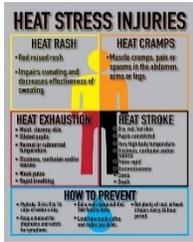
