One-Shot Script:

Chapter 1: The Goddess Descends

Panel 1: Mc extremely depressed, in room, on bed.

Panel 2: Glowing light shining from off screen.

Panel 3: Goddess descends down through holy light and giving off heavenly air.

Goddess: I am a Goddess of depression. Having descended down from a realm beyond, for our fated meeting.

Goddess: For you are the host of legend, seldom told of.

Panel 4: Mc not impressed face.

Chapter 2: Listen here...

Panel 1: Goddess in foreground. Mc in background. They are staring at each other.

Panel 2: (Same shot) Mc just lies down. The Goddess is shocked.

Panel 3: Mc foreground. Goddess in background, emanating agitated energy.

Mc: I don't have the energy for this.

Panel 4: Close up of the Goddess, giving off big Yandere vibe.

Goddess: Listen here you little shit.

Chapter 3: Beyond Comprehension

Panel 1: Goddess is pressing her nose up against Mc's. Mc is uncomfortable. Goddess is still mad.

Goddess: I am something beyond your basic ass human comprehension. Don't act like you "just got a message you don't want to respond to". So, sit up and pay attention.

Mc: Okay, I get it. Back off a little. (Small text in box) I'm already sitting up.

Panel 2: Goddess giving holy energy in praying pose.

Goddess: You must be wondering, why such an incomprehensibly special being, such as myself, has descended upon you?

Panel 3: Mc giving her a side eye, with eyebrow raised.

Mc: I guess...

Panel 4: Goddess gives a menacing head tilt.

Goddess: More enthusiasm.

Mc (Starburst): Yes miss, please tell me!

Chapter 4: ...In The World!

Panel 1: Mc sitting on his calves, with his hands-on knees.

Mc: So, why has a Goddess shown up in front of me?

Panel 2: Goddess pointing at self, and pointing at viewer.

Goddess: As I said, I am a goddess of depression, here for you.

Mc: Why me?

Panel 3: Goddess with hands extended out. Dramatic fish eye lens shot, placed towards end of hand.

Goddess: That's because, you are the most depressed person in the world!

Panel 4: Mc with completely blank expression.

Mc: Eh?

Chapter 5: Why Are You Here?

Panel 1: Mc scratching ear. Surprised Goddess face in foreground.

Mc: Most depressed person on the planet, yeah okay, that seems about right.

Goddess: Accepted so easily.

Panel 2: Mc arms folded, tilted to the side.

Mc: I mean, it's not that surprising.

Mc: Anyways, what are you here for?

Panel 3: Goddess having clapped her hands together with a happy, moe face. Flowers and sparkles in the background.

Goddess: To harvest your depression.

Panel 4: Mc giving a

Chapter 6: The Impossible

Panel 1: Chibi Goddess, pointing to diagram. Diagram: Simply drawn person, with depression aura, being absorbed by simply drawn goddess.

Goddess: You see, us Depression Goddesses can harvest depression from our creators.

Goddess: We can then use it to fuel our powers and life force.

Panel 2: Mc bent over, hand on chin, looking at diagram.

Mc: What would happen, if I stopped being depressed?

Panel 3: Goddess sparkly smile.

Goddess: Let's not worry about the impossible.

Panel 4: Mc looking down, sad.



Chapter 7: Suckle

Panel 1: Boy looking over and down, feeling sad.

Mc: So, you're here to suckle on my energy?

Panel 2: Goddess with a blank stare.

Panel 3: Same shot closer.

Panel 4: Same shot REALLY close.

Goddess: Never say that again.

Mc: Okay...

Chapter 8: Can I Say No?

Panel 1: Goddess holding hand in front of her mouth, making ahem noise into it.

Goddess: Ahem, yes, I am here to satisfy my cravings, using your depression.

Panel 2: Mc with raised finger.

Mc: Can I say no?

Panel 3: Goddess sparkle.

Goddess: No, you cannot.

Panel 4: Same shot, Mc with bent, raised finger.

Mc: But I don't-

Goddess (This bubble overlapping the other): No, you cannot!

Chapter 9: Advanced

Panel 1: Mc with arms folded.

Mc: Okay, I guess I kind of understand. (Small text bottom of bubble): Not really.

Mc: But why my depression?

Panel 2: Goddess wagging finger.

Goddess [SFX]: Tsk, tsk, tsk

Goddess: You just don't get it, do you?

Panel 3: Mc giving head tilt.

Mc: Enlighten me.

Panel 4: Goddess excited. Pose:



Goddess: Because this isn't your everyday depression, this is Advanced Depression.

Chapter 10: Walls Are Made To Be Broken

Panel 1: Mc raises hand.

Mc: Wait, did you just say, harvest depression from your creators?

Panel 2: Goddess gives head tilt. Simplistic oval white eyes, with one eyelash.

Goddess: Hm, did I? When?

Panel 3: Mc points with his thumb, to a smaller version of the panel, he is referencing. VFX around it.

Mc: Nineteen panels ago.

Panel 4: Goddess shocked face. Brick wall breaking in background.

Goddess: Breaking the fourth wall already!?

Chapter 11: Children

Panel 1: Goddess, seeming excited.

Goddess: Yes well, it's because of you, that I came into existence.

Panel 2: Chibi Mc.

Mc: Eh, really?

Panel 3: Goddess nodding her head, cutely.

Goddess: Yep, in a way, you're like my parent.

Panel 4: Mc holding up hand, with overly serious face.

Mc: I ain't paying child support.

Goddess: You ruined the moment.

Chapter 12: Are You Thinking...?

Panel 1: Mc looking at chibi Goddess.

Mc: So, my depression made you?

Panel 2: Mc thinking deeply, arms crossed.

Panel 3: Goddess, clapped hands together tilted to the side, by her face.

Goddess: Are you thinking "finally something good has come from my depression." You are, right?

Panel 4: Mc giving judging expression.

Mc: That's to be decided.

Chapter 13: Brief Hope

Panel 1: Chibi Goddess looking off, lips pursed. [SFX] Phfu

Goddess: And here I thought I'd get something to eat.

Panel 2: Mc scratching his cheek.

Mc: You mean my depression? Why would you get some from that?

Panel 3: Goddess perked up.

Goddess: Ah, you see when you get less depressed, the excess is expelled and absorbed by me.

Panel 4: Smiling Mc

Mc: Then, you're here to help me be happier?

Goddess: Nope. (Little star drawing)

Mc: Oh...

Chapter 14: Depression Meter

Panel 1: Goddess pointing up at, Depression meter. +/- = same result.

Goddess: Both lowering and raising your depression level, works just fine.

Panel 2: Mc sunk into himself.

Mc: I see.

Panel 3: Same shot, Mc bouncing forward with some vigor.

Mc: Wait, if both ways work, why not just only lower my depression?

Panel 4: Goddess, eyes closed, shrugging her shoulders, with her hands raised up.

Goddess: Because increasing it is easier.

Chapter 15: Speedrun

Panel 1: Mc with vacant eyes.

Mc: You're a mean little Goddess, aren't you?

Panel 2: Goddess sticking tongue out, hits top of her head.

Goddess: Teehee.

Panel 3: Mc looking to the side, with vacant eyes. Link looking at pixel Mario spinning around. VFX: 1/7,000,000,000,000 (One in seven trillion metric).



Mc: You're treating my misery like a game you're speed running.

Panel 4: Goddess sticking tongue out, hits top of her head.

Goddess: Teehee.

Mc: Knock it off. [VFX Anger Vein Symbol. (In Bubble).]

Chapter 16: Hmm

Panel 1: Goddess holding open palm out.

Goddess: So, what do you say?!

Panel 2: Mc hemming and humming.

Mc: Hmm.

Mc: Mhh.

Panel 3:

Mc hemming and humming. Goddess holding hand out, ready.

Mc: Hmm.

Mc: Mhh.

Panel 4: Mc hemming and humming. Goddess holding hand out, annoyed.

Mc: Hmm.

Panel 1:

Goddess yelling out.

Panel 2:

Panel 3:

Goddess popping forward, hands clenched in front of her, bright eyes blushed face.

Panel 4:

Mc blushing.

Panel 1:

Goddess, talking with herself, looking happy.

Panel 2:

Mc still somewhat blushing, scratching side of chin.

Mc: I'm glad you're happy, but what now?

Panel 3:

Goddess blankly staring back.

Panel 4:

Goddess blankly staring back.

Chapter 19: Incompetent

Panel 1:

Mc staring at camera blankly, hands in front of his face, hands together with pointer fingers pointed up.

Panel 2:

Mc staring at camera blankly, in same pose, but hands pointed forward.

Panel 3:

Goddess, shocked, and shouting.

Goddess: How rude!

Panel 4:

Goddess in same pose, but calm now.

Panel 1:

Mc: An incompetent little Depression Goddess.

Panel 2:

Goddess floating behind Mc.
