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## Unofficial Minutes Muscatine School Board of Education Regular Session April 14, 2025

The Board of Education of the Muscatine Community School District, in the County of Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in regular session on Monday, April 14, 2025, at 6:15 p.m. at the Muscatine Community School District Administration Center in the Boardroom. President Lindsey Phillips called the meeting to order. Directors; Matt Conard, Karen Cooney, John Dabeet, Kim Schneider, Dennis Schuur were present. Director Ken LaRue was absent. Student School Board Representatives, Kira Holler and McKenna Schumaker were absent. Superintendent Clint Christopher, Director of Finance Tom Anderson and Director of Operations Chris Nienhaus were present.

The board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Phillips welcomed visitors and media representatives.

A motion was made by Director Dabeet and seconded by Director Schuur to open the public hearing for the certification of the proposed Fiscal Year 2026 budget. Roll was called to open the hearing. Ayes: Conard, Cooney, Dabeet, Phillips, Schneider, Schuur; Nays, none. Motion carried: 6:16 pm.

No written or oral comments were received.

The board recognized the Muscatine High School Boys Bowling Team for their first state championship. Coach Triscia Laucamp and team members Derrick Lewandowski and Owen Riley spoke about the bowling season and winning the state championship.

No Student School Board Representative report was given.

No one spoke at Citizen's Speak.

As part of the Board Targets/Goal, "Muscatine Schools will utilize resources effectively and equitably", Shane Williams and Kim Hofmann of Mississippi Bend Area Education Agency (MBAEA) reviewed the English Language (EL) Program Audit. The review process included; classroom walkthroughs, data analysis, caseload review, teacher surveys and recommendations. Mr. Williams and Ms Hofmann reviewed the program highlights and recommendations for the EL program.

During the Superintendent Update, Superintendent Christopher thanked the MBAEA for their support in reviewing the EL Program. Superintendent Christopher updated the board on the 2% State Supplemental Aid (SSA) funding. The 2% equates to \$240 million dollars; of that \$100 million is designated for the Education Saving Accounts (ESA) for private schools. Superintendent Christopher stated private schools should follow the same rules as public schools for reporting the use of public funds. Superintendent Christopher shared the Muscatine graduation rate has grown significantly, and continues to have a positive trend line. Superintendent

Christopher thanked Director of Student Services Becky Wichers for her dedication and years of service to the Muscatine Community School District and announced that Jennifer Fridley will be taking over the position in July.
