 - 2023-2024 Goals
 - Goal #1: Using Land Trust funding for a full day kindergarten class allows us to implement Early Literacy Intervention (OEK) for the 2023-24 school year. We will use the Acadience Assessment for our data. Bacchus will have 60% of Kindergarteners reach their typical or above typical progress goal (POP goal) on the End of year Acadience Reading and Math benchmark tests.
 - Reading: 68% **Yay, we made our goal!**
 - Math: 64% **Yay, we made our goal!**
 - Goal #2 (**Amend**): Students will increase their proficiency on the Science RISE assessment in the Spring of 2024 (compared to the performance of each grade level in the Spring of 2023) by five percentage points in all grade levels . If we build time for weekly grade level PLC time focusing on effective PLC activities, data and student learning, then we will increase teacher collaboration, response to data, and increase student achievement.
 - Amend to: **Overall RISE Achievement**: Compared to schoolwide performance on the 2023 RISE, students' average test performance on the 2024 RISE will increase by 3% to a schoolwide proficiency rate of 25%. If we build time for weekly grade level PLC time focusing on effective PLC activities, data and student learning, then we will increase teacher collaboration, response to data, and increase student achievement.
 - Reading: 18%
 - Math: 18%
 - Science: 18%

We did not make our RISE goals, in fact we got lower than before. We will continue to work on helping our students learn and get more students to proficiency in reading, math, and science. We discuss frequently how to get our students to proficiency and what practices we need to put into place.
