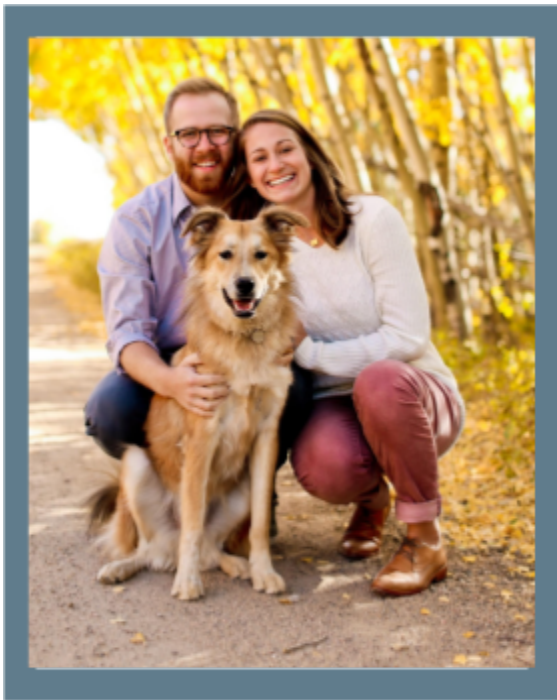




A Learning Experience that Changed Me:
