Join us on a tour of the Coast Guard Station Golden Gate. We will tour the Station and the Motor Life Boat. Students will participate in activities to learn about search and rescue on the coast and in the ocean.

Established in 1987, Station Golden Gate is the busiest search and rescue station on the Pacific coast, averaging over 600 cases per year, with a geographic responsibility extending along the Pacific coast from Point Reyes to Point Ano Nuevo, including the Farallon Islands, and within San Francisco Bay from Bluff Point to Pier 39.
