Welcome, I'm Catrinel Menghia and I'm the Stable Leader of World of Fight and this is my report on our recent event. Our fighters just finished up fighting in the UCC's 10th regular sanctioned event on the frozen 7th continent of Antarctica. Why fight in the least populated place on earth? Nobody knows for sure but the thought was that the events were starting to gain popularity and the UCC administrators wanted to keep the “*Underground Atmosphere*”. Despite the secrecy of the previous undisclosed locations, the word was getting out and fans were starting to show up in droves threatening to expose the League to the horrible liability lawsuits that brought the UMMA to a crashing halt.

Having the event in a place where literally nobody could attend made sense. I didn't run across a single competitor who wanted to be there but the few in attendance were loud and fully got behind us. World of Fight was 2-0 and successfully defended our Featherweight and Middleweight titles. In fact going into the event we had the top 4 Middleweights and for the 3rd straight event we will fight each other for the title.

The Centerfold Angels brag about their success but World of Fight is the only Stable currently holding 2 titles. Their top fighter Jessa Hinton may hold the top spot in the rankings but none of their other fighters are in the top 10 while World of Fight and the Badass Barbies each have 3.

We had a successful event winning 17 fights while losing 8. This may not have been our best event but if you take out our 6 fighters who fought teammates then our 14-5 records is a lot easier to swallow. Our event could not have started out any better than it did. Our Featherweights came out and took no prisoners winning all 6 of their fights and our Welterweights held their own winning 5 of 6.

I keep reading a bunch of crap about World of Fight trading Emma Watson. Everyone needs to be realistic and we would never trade one of the top fighters in the history of female MMA. Kylie may be our owner for the immediate future but there is no way in hell that she is going to end up with Emma.

So far the UCC has been going on for 2 years. We have had 13 events which is far short of the hectic schedule in the UMMA but it still has plenty of action nonetheless. For this Month's TKO article, I'm going to change it up a little and give the entire World of Fight Roster a report card.



Emma Watson (16-3) UCC Ranking #4 Grade A

Emma has been out top fighter and would have received an A+ if she hadn't had a slip in the last Tournament. She is the current Middleweight Champion and has a Tournament win to go along with her 5 most ranking points. She has 2 Wins of the Night, 2 KO's of the Night, and 2 Submissions of the Night proving that she is a well rounded fighter and has twice been held the top spot in the entire UCC.

Isla Fisher (16-4) UCC Ranking #6 Grade A

Isla is without a doubt the most underrated fighter in the UCC. She has quietly climbed to the 6th overall ranking without the fanfare. At only 5'2" Isla has chopped down the taller competition and will look to capture the title against Emma at the next event.

Catrinel Menghia (17-4) UCC Ranking #9 Grade A

I hate self evaluations but if I had to grade myself I' like to think that I deserve an A. while I lost the title to Kara Monaco I rebounded and won it back and don;t plan on ever giving it up.

Bar Refaeli (17-4) UCC Ranking #15 Grade A-

Bar receives an A- mainly due to the fact that she has lost her last 2 fights. Bar will get a shot at one of her recent losses when she takes on Kaley Cuoco in Moscow.

Malin Akerman (15-5) UCC Rank #19 Grade B+

Malin has been in a top 10 Middleweight since the 2nd event and has been a model of consistency. Her recent loss to Isla wasn't her best effort but we'll be seeing Malin challenging for the title in no time.

Doutzen Kroes (12-5) UCC Ranking #37 Grade B

Doutzen avenged her two earlier losses to her rival Selena Gomez and made the recent tournament finals. Doutzen is primed to make a run to the top but will have to get by teammate Emily VanCamp in Russia.

Emily VanCamp (14-6) UCC Ranking #43 Grade B-

Emily had a great start but has faded lately losing 4 of her last 8. 2 wins of the night against Belen Rodriguez have been overshadowed by crushing losses to Kira Kosarin, Raquel Pomplun, and Selena Gomez.

Sophie Monk (11-3) UCC Ranking #46 Grade B+

Sophie is our only fighter who has been in every fight. 2 of her 3 losses came to controversial decisions and her other loss was a shocking 5th round KO.



Adriana Lima (13-6) UCC Ranking #49 Grade B-

Adriana has had her moments but has struggled in big fights. Her rival, Leryn Franco has come on and had beaten Adriana in their last 2 fights. Adriana recently climbed back into the top 25 but has now lost 2 in a row.

Penelope Cruz (13-6) UCC Ranking #60 Grade B-

Penelope had a great start and positioned herself for a title shot when she beat Lais Ribero but a poor Tournament showing dropped her in the rankings and she has been struggling ever since. She looks to be back on track after winning 3 of her last 4.

Rachel McAdams (12-7) UCC Ranking #79 Grade C+

Rachel is one of our most talented fighters and one of our most inconsistent. She has had 4 and 5 fight win streaks but also had 2 fight losing streaks 3 times. She has plenty of power but struggles against faster fighters. A switch to a heavier division may be in store for Rachel.

Aida Yespica (10-7) UCC Ranking #101 Grade D+

With impressive wins over Shailene Woodley and Amber Heard, we expect Aida to bring it to the cage every fight. Unfortunately she is either on or off and lately it has mostly been the latter. Aida has been put on probation and if she doesn't win her next fight she may be released.

Mila Kunis (10-6) UCC Ranking #102 Grade C+

Mila started out her UCC career 8-2 and was 4th in the rankings and headed towards the top. Lately she has fallen on hard times and has gone 2-4 since. She is coming off a big win over Katie Melua and hopes to build on that.



Olga Kurylenko (11-7) UCC Ranking #103 Grade C

Olga is sometimes more bark than bite. Like Mila, Olga started out 8-2 and has gone 3-5 and is riding a 2 fight losing streak. Olga is banned from the Forum until she can put together some wins.



Malika Sherawat (10-7) UCC Ranking #128 Grade C-

Strictly being a ground fighter limits Malika when she faces fighters with good takedown defense. With a 2 fight losing streak Malika needs to win or face being released.

Cheryl Cole (10-7) UCC Ranking #132 Grade C

Cheryl is one of our better fighters who continually disappoints. Another 8-2 start she has not been her normal self losing 5 of her next 7. There is hope as Cheryl just broke a 5 fight losing streak with a big KO win over Vanessa Hudgens.

Sabine Jemeljanova (10-7) UCC Ranking #133 Grade D-

Being a 5 star fighter comes with a lot of expectations. Sabine had success in the UMMA and the UCC but has some major letdowns. Sabine won her first 6 then suffered a 4 fight losing streak, won 3 in a row and is now on a 2 fight losing streak. Sabine will be fighting Sofia Richie in Russia. It's a fight she should handily win but if she struggles then she might find herself looking for another stable.

Alexis Ren (5-1) UCC Ranking #145 Grade A

Alexis is an amazing talent. She won her first 4 then lost to top seeded Eugenie Bouchard. She rebounded with a huge win over Ana Ivanovic and will look to start another win streak when she fights Bebe Rexha at UCC XI.



Elizabetta Canalis (8-6) UCC Ranking #152 Grade D-

Strictly being a ground fighter has hindered Elizabetta's potential. She has been struggling to keep herself above .500 and has struggled against talented strikers. We've tried to teach her striking and it's been a long process but are not giving up on her quite yet.

Natalie Portman (7-5) UCC Ranking #163 Grade B

Natalie has been impressive since being picked up from the Vixens winning 4 of her 5 fights her only loss coming to top ranked Miley Cyrus. She will face another big test when she fights Karate Diva's Katie Melua at the next event.

Mischa Barton (8-7) UCC Ranking #168 Grade C-

Mischa has had a rough go so far. She has won some big fights and come up short in others. She has also been slighted on a few occasions but Mischa sticks with it no matter the outcome. We have confidence in her and expect her to be in contention by the end of the year.

Shanina Shaik (3-1) UCC Ranking #216 Grade B+

Shanina has impressed us so far with a submission win, a win by injury, and a decision win. She has a tremendous attitude and is the first in the gym and the last to leave. We see a bright future for Shanina.



Kate Beckinsale (6-7) UCC Ranking #203 Grade A-

When we signed Kate everyone told us that at 0-6 she was washed up and over the hill. Since joining World of Fight Kate has gone 6-1 with her only loss coming to the top fighters in the UCC. While she lost to Jessa Hinton at the last tournament, she took her deep into the 5th before falling short.

Shanina Shaik (3-1) UCC Ranking #216 Grade B+

Shanina has impressed us so far with a submission win, a win by injury, and a decision win. She has a tremendous attitude and is the first in the gym and the last to leave. We see a bright future for Shanina.

Deepika Padukone (3-1) UCC Ranking #217 Grade A

Deepika could easily be undefeated. Her only loss came to Dua Lipa in a fight that saw her lose a split decision where she out hit her 62 to 3.

Ana de Armas (2-2) UCC Ranking #340 Grade C

Ana has a ton of potential but has struggled at times in the cage. She's had some tough losses and her only 2 wins are against Felicity Feline. Ana will look to start a win streak when she fights Katarina Ivanovski in Russia.
