<p>Use <a href="#">this example</a> to help you create word ladders with different word pairs.</p> <p>Option: Use sidewalk chalk to create your word ladder on the sidewalk or your driveway. How long can you stretch your ladder?</p>	<p>Write a letter to a character from a book you read. In your letter, share your opinion about the character's actions in the story. Would you have made the same choices as the character? Why or why not?</p>	<p>Choose a book to read. Write a new ending to the story. How can you write an ending that is different from the one in your book?</p>
<p><b>Scrabble</b></p> <p>Make 3-4 copies of the <a href="#">Letter Tiles</a>. Cut out the letters to play a game of Scrabble.</p>	<p><b>Read Aloud</b></p> <p>Pick your favorite book and read it to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An adult in your house</li> <li>• A pet</li> <li>• Your favorite stuffed animal or toy</li> </ul>	<p><b>Nonfiction Reading</b></p> <p>Choose a topic you are interested in and read 2 books on that topic.</p> <p>Using what you learned from reading the books, create your own book on the topic. Use facts, pictures, diagrams, labels and important words to develop your book.</p>
<p><b>Letter to a Friend</b></p> <p>Write a letter to a friend telling them about an exciting thing that happened to you during the week. Mail the letter to your friend. Remember to use your best letter formation :-)</p>	<p><b>Story Illustrator</b></p> <p>Choose a book to read. Draw a new front cover for the book, including the title, author and illustrator.</p> <p>Option: <i>Neighborhood Book Advertisements</i>- Use sidewalk chalk to illustrate your front cover on your sidewalk. How many book advertisements can you create using the squares on your sidewalk?</p>	<p><b>Word Art</b></p> <p>Find 5-7 important words from the nonfiction books you read. Using items found in nature, create an art project with your words. For example - rock art: paint your words on a rock, use pebbles to create your words, use a combination of sticks and rocks to write your words.</p>
