#### **Rules and Regulations**

Parking at Danbury High School is a **privilege** afforded to students who attend school regularly. Parking privileges can be denied or revoked if a passing grade is not achieved in at least four courses. All fines must be paid in full before purchasing any school/class event tickets. Parking privileges will be revoked if the school and parking lot rules are violated. Examples of these violations include, but are not limited to:

- SPEEDING
- LEAVING OR ENTERING THROUGH THE INCORRECT AREA
- RECKLESS DRIVING OR RECKLESS ENDANGERMENT
- MISUSE OF PARKING PERMIT
- LEAVING SCHOOL GROUNDS

## No refunds will be given for any revoked permits.

Each applicant will be issued two parking decals. Parking decal distribution will begin on 8/20 at the DHS security booth. Please bring ID and payment in the form of cash or check at the time of pick up.

Decals are not transferable and are valid only in the student parking lot. No decal will be replaced unless the registered vehicle is sold or the windshield is replaced and proof of such is furnished.

- THE DECAL MUST BE PERMANENTLY AFFIXED TO THE DRIVER'S SIDE LOWER LEFT CORNER, INSIDE THE FRONT WINDSHIELD.
- DECALS ARE NOT CONSIDERED VALID IF THEY ARE NOT AFFIXED TO THE WINDSHIELD
- DECALS CANNOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES BE GIVEN TO ANOTHER STUDENT

#### D.H.S PARKING VIOLATIONS

1st - Warning Ticket

2<sup>nd</sup> -\$10.00 fine

3<sup>rd</sup> - \$10.00 fine, a referral for insubordination resulting in a two-hour detention, second offense is one-day ISS, parent/guardian contact, and possible removal of the vehicle. (Towed at owner's expense.)

All fines will accrue by \$10.00 for every ticket received after the warning.

A temporary pass can be issued in certain circumstances. Students must obtain this pass from the School Safety Advocates' office.

## **FAQs**

- 1. Do I need a permit to park on DHS property?
  - a. Yes, between 7:00 am, and 2:00 pm, DHS parking lots are permit parking only. After 2:00 pm, you can park at DHS
- 2. What happens if I park at DHS without a permit?
  - a. You will be warned, then ticketed, possibly receive a detention or ISS, and could be towed at the owner's expense.
- 3. What do I do if someone is in my spot?
  - a. Safety Advocates will be monitoring the parking lot, just like years past. You notify them and then park in the unmarked spots by Eastgate Rd.
  - b. If you can't find a Safety Advocate, please tell an administrator.
- 4. Can sophomores park on school grounds?
  - a. No, parking is only available for Seniors and Juniors. We do not have enough spots for everyone.
  - b. Spots are sold to Seniors first, then Juniors. First-come, first-served. We do not have enough spots for everyone.
- 5. How many spots are there?
  - a. There are currently 385 spots. When those spots are filled, there are no more spots available.
