- **12. List** the the <u>title and author</u> of one book you've read in high school that you enjoyed and could use to answer the AP exam's Q3 essay this year (5 points).
- **13. List three themes** you could write about using **one book** you read this summer for the AP exam's Q3 essay this year (5 points). Examples include jealousy, coming-of-age, perseverance. Make sure to say which book you are discussing.

- **14.** Who wrote this play? Incorrect if spelled wrong. (5 points total)
- 15. When was this play written? (date must be within 10 years to be correct) (5 pts total)
- **16.** What country is the author from? (nationality) (5 points total)
- **17. Character map**: Write the names of a 5+ characters and connect them with **short** descriptions of how they are related / connected.
- **18.** How is this story influenced by its historical context? **List 3-5** characteristics of the time period this text was written in and **describe** how these characteristics are reflected in the play through specific references to the characters and the plot. (10 points total)
- 19. ½ page to 1 page ESSAY QUESTION--answer using "demonstrative statements" (15 points total)
- 20. ½ page to 1 page ESSAY QUESTION (15 points total)
