

Housing and Utilities

Need housing?

1. **Call/ Text 211** and ask for housing assistance.
2. **Call or visit a public center e.g. DMH (Mental Health), SAPC (Substance Abuse), CES Access Points, etc.** listed below.
 - Tell them that you **need housing**.

If you need more help, **call or visit** any **LA Care Resource Center** for Housing Assistance, etc.

- They can help you sign up for housing, medical insurance (*Medi-Cal, Medicare, VA, private entities, etc.*), GR cash aid, CalFresh EBT, a free phone, free internet, child care, and other financial assistance.

*They should be able to assign you with a **case worker** who can help you ***apply for programs***.

- SAPC (Substance Abuse)
- other public and **private** entities
- CES Access Points

CES ACCESS POINTS

If you are currently homeless, you can get connected to housing through CES.

Start by calling **211** and asking for a CES housing assessment.

You can also visit:

- LA Family Housing
- The People Concern
- Union Station Homeless Services (Pasadena)

They will complete your assessment and connect you to resources.
