<p>Notify Bridges Middle School of the absence due to covid symptoms or a positive test.</p> <p>Email: Attendance Keeper</p>	<p>Please wear a mask for 5 days after exposure-test on morning of day 6, prior to coming to school.</p> <p>Notify Bridges Middle School of the exposure so we can support your student in wearing the mask while at school.</p> <p>Email: Attendance Keeper</p>	<p>This is considered a new exposure. Student will have to start the steps over at either scenario 1 or 2, depending on whether they have symptoms or not.</p>
Keep your student home until symptoms are improving and fever free for 24 hours without fever/pain reducing medication.	Test is positive and has no symptoms	
Can then return to school wearing a mask for 5 days or until negative test.	Wear a mask for another 5 days or until test negative	
Student is testing negative, no mask required.	If tests positive on day 6 with symptoms, start at top of scenario 1.	
	Test is negative on day 6, no mask is required	

NOTE: Day 0 = Day of exposure
