



Skip Counting

Math, Grades K-2

Assignment Objectives

- Students will be able to understand numeric patterns.
- The Live Help Feature will be utilized for this activity.

Teacher Instructions

- In the chart below, fill out the “Count By” and “Start With” columns.
- Provide each student with a copy.
- Instruct students to log on to Paper and start a Live Help session with a tutor.
- Ask students to use the collaborative whiteboard in their Live Help session to find the numbers that belong in the set.

Example:

Count By	Start With	Number Sets
2	16	<u>18</u> , <u>20</u> , <u>22</u> , <u>24</u> , <u>26</u> , <u>28</u> , <u>30</u> , <u>32</u> , <u>34</u> , <u>36</u>
5	25	<u>30</u> , <u>35</u> , <u>40</u> , <u>45</u> , <u>50</u> , <u>55</u> , <u>60</u> , <u>65</u> , <u>70</u> , <u>75</u>

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Student Instructions

You will work with a Live Help tutor to complete number sets for skip counting.

1. Start a Live Help session with a Paper tutor.
2. Explain to your tutor what number you are skip counting by and what your starting number is.
3. You will complete 10 numbers in the set with your Paper tutor.
4. Use the collaborative whiteboard to draw pictures and number lines to help you find the numbers in the set. Write them in order under the “Number Sets” column.
5. Turn-in the completed sheet to your teacher.
