Assignment Objectives

- Students will be able to understand numeric patterns.
- The Live Help Feature will be utilized for this activity.

Teacher Instructions

- In the chart below, fill out the "Count By" and "Start With" columns.
- Provide each student with a copy.
- Instruct students to log on to Paper and start a Live Help session with a tutor.
- Ask students to use the collaborative whiteboard in their Live Help session to find the numbers that belong in the set.

Student Instructions

You will work with a Live Help tutor to complete number sets for skip counting.

- 3. You will complete 10 numbers in the set with your Paper tutor.
- 4. Use the collaborative whiteboard to draw pictures and number lines to help you find the numbers in the set. Write them in order under the "Number Sets" column.
- 5. Turn-in the completed sheet to your teacher.
