Tree-planting Programs

Stream ReLeaf Tree-planting Program

The <u>Stream ReLeaf</u> program helps property owners plant riparian buffers along a stream which help prevent erosion, provide vegetative cover, and trap nutrients. Thousands of trees have been planted this way. Eligible property owners must commit to planting a minimum of a dozen trees or shrubs within 75 feet of a stream. Recreation and Parks' staff will work with homeowners on a personalized plan.

Turf to Trees Tree-planting Program

This Recreation and Parks program provides trees and planting services to Howard County property owners with lots of 1.5 to 10 acres in size, free of cost, with the aim of reducing stormwater runoff by increasing asing tree coverage throughout the county. Property owners in the program must plant and maintain a minimum of 50 trees, provided by the County and then maintained by the property owner. * <u>Turf to Trees</u>

Tree Canopy Tree-planting Program

The <u>Tree Canopy</u> program focuses on tree planting in communities with lower tree canopy coverage. Full size, native species, canopy trees are prioritized with the goal of providing shade and reduce heat islands. The county provides the trees; the property owners must commit to planting and maintaining one to 10 trees on their property. An emphasis is given to planting full-size canopy trees.

The date for this annual event offered by the HoCoGov Parks & Rec is not yet set. Registration usually begins in early September with the tree pick up in early October. All trees gifted through this program (over 12,000 to date) are native species and well-adapted to the local climate and conditions. Past tree-give-aways have included Eastern Redbud, River Birch, Northern Red Oak, Swamp White Oak, Red Maple, Sycamore, American Hornbeam, Flowering Dogwood, Black Gum and more. The trees are typically 5- to 8-feet tall.

Tips when submitting updates

For events–when and where possible–link to an organization's EVENTS page on Facebook, not to the actual event on Facebook. *Why?* Many events are annual, and that link will get old and not work for future years, and the more self-refreshing this document is, the better. **Here's the trick:** Instead of linking to, for example, the *2025 Earth Day event page* on an organization's website, go to the organization's website event page, but first put in a search term: In this case, it would be *Earth Day*. Hit enter (to activate the search), then copy that link. (See below for an example.) By adding event information this way, the link and resource will stay fresher. Thank you!
