## The 4 Stages of Dark

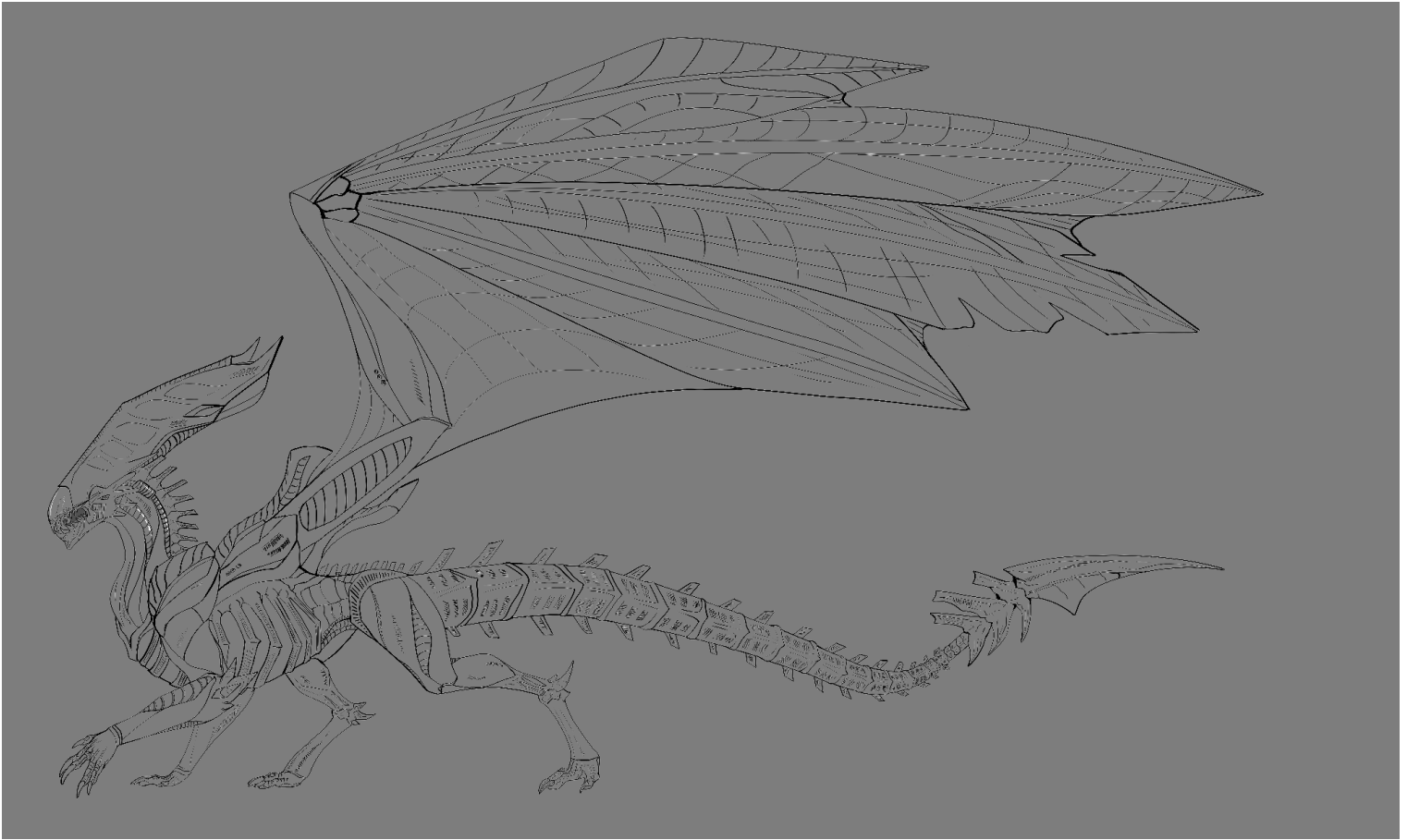

After half a year of incubation within his host, he emerges, killing his host.

### Alignment: True Neutral

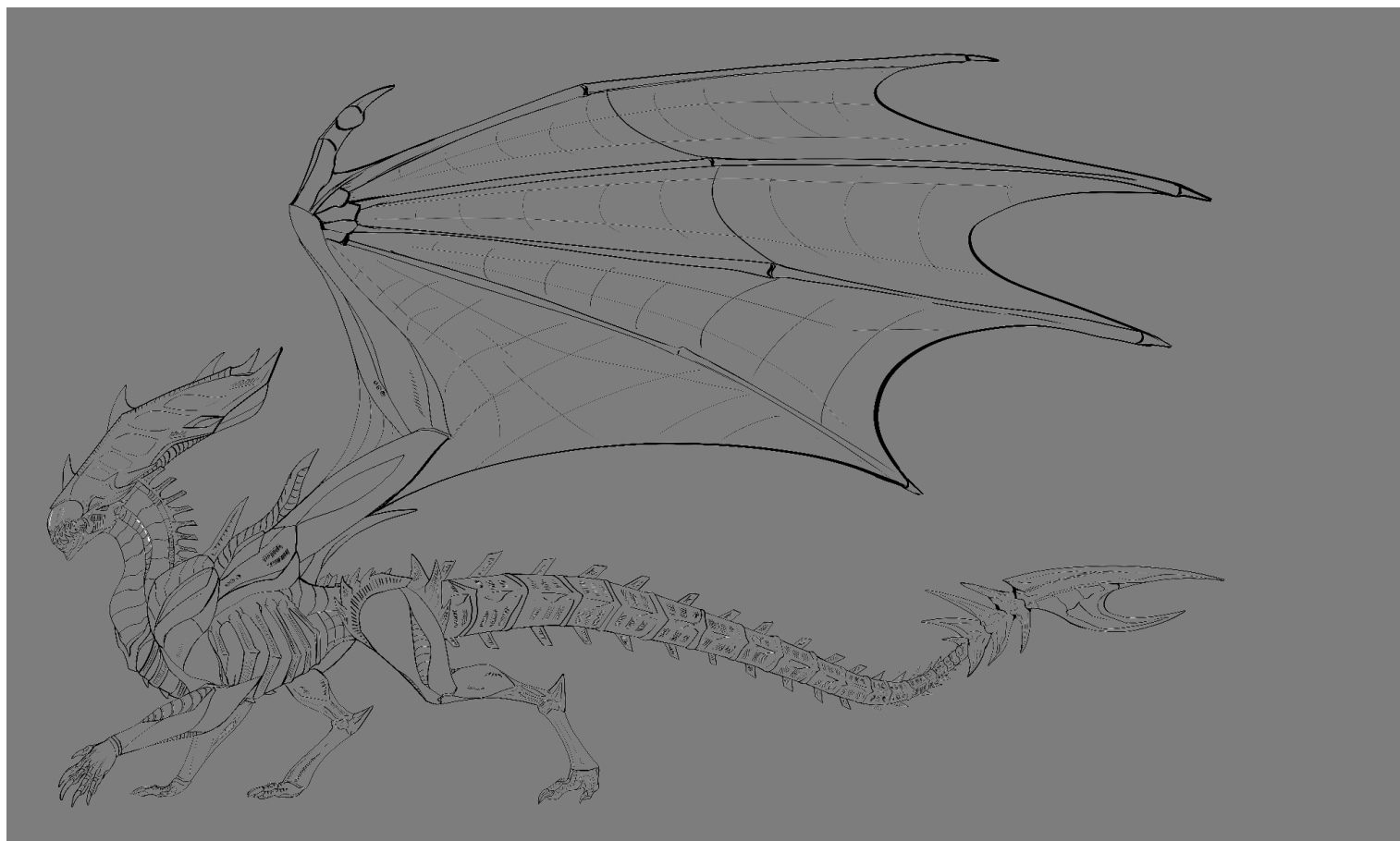
In his first stage, Dark is a silent, calculating predator who operates alone as a scout, hunter, and guardian of his species. He spends most of his time outside hives, patrolling the wilds and maintaining control over surrounding territory. His focus is simple—secure land, eliminate external threats, and protect the growth of nearby hives.

His methods are efficient and deliberate. He hunts with patience, studying prey before striking, using fear and misdirection to weaken them long before the kill. He thrives on control, ensuring his targets feel hunted and cornered even in their own territory. Though driven by duty, he takes quiet pleasure in the fear and suffering of his prey when it aligns with his efficiency.

Dark does not threaten or discipline his own kind. All xenomorphs are family to him, each with a role in the hive's survival. He avoids internal conflict, never judging or punishing, and obeys any queen's command without hesitation. Power, leadership, and recognition hold no meaning for him—only function and purpose.

While his hunts are ruthless, they are not driven by mindless cruelty. Every kill serves the hive’s survival. Yet, if efficiency allows, he indulges in drawn-out hunts, savoring the fear, despair, and gradual collapse of his prey before delivering the final strike.

Stage 2 Enforcer(Lawful Neutral)

In his second stage, Dark is no longer just a silent hunter—he becomes the hive’s primary source of discipline and internal control. His intelligence has developed into a sharp, instinct-based awareness that lets him read intent, recognize disobedience, and react with deliberate action. He is now capable of regulating behavior within the hive, shaping compliance through presence, posture, and calculated punishment.

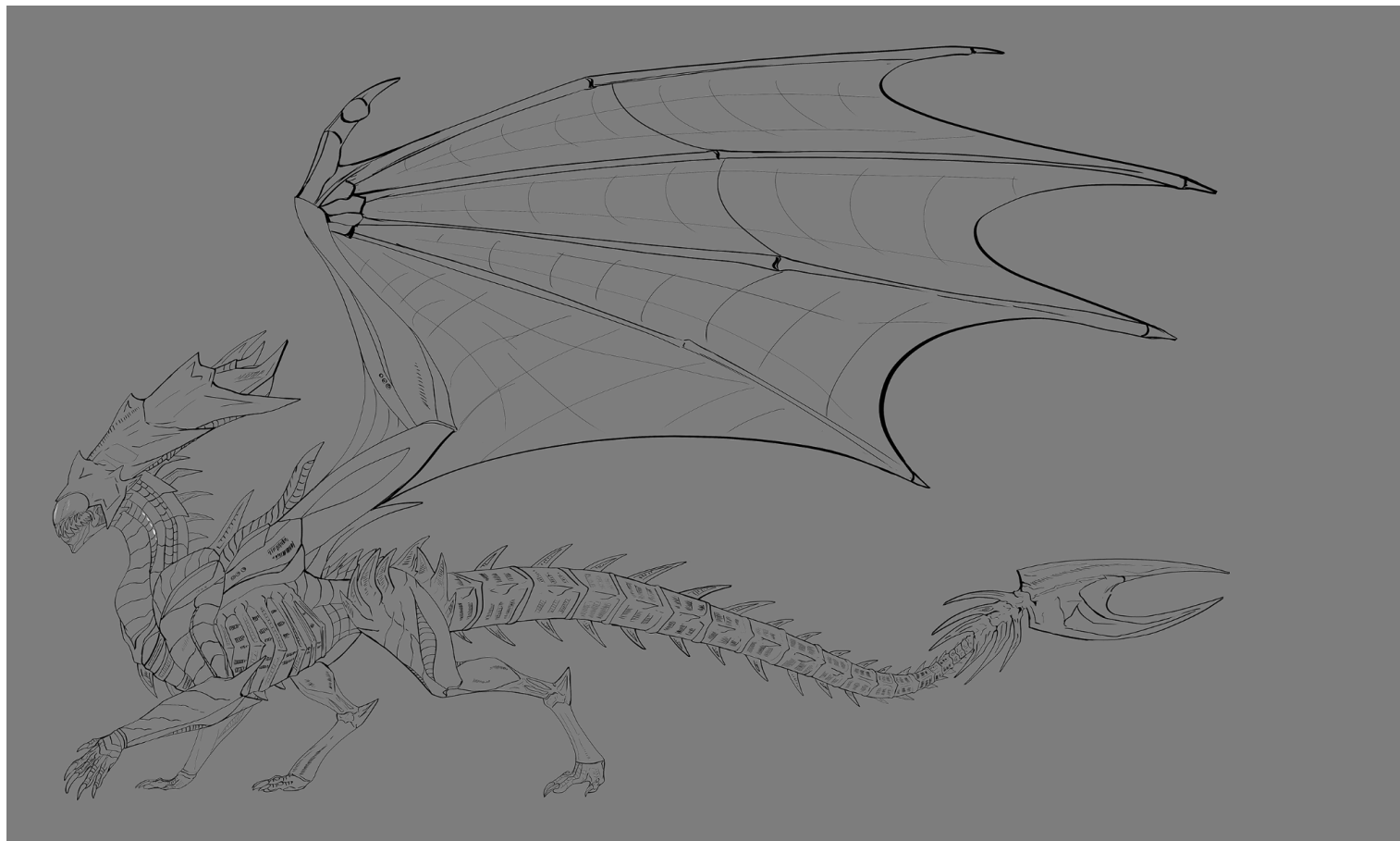
He uses fear as a functional tool for maintaining stability. Failure, disruption, or refusal to obey is met with escalating correction—intimidation, force, or removal, depending on the risk posed. He studies patterns in behavior and can anticipate defiance before it occurs, acting before disorder spreads. However, his role is

not limited to punishment—he also safeguards the lower castes, protecting workers, drones, eggs, and young from threats inside and outside the hive.

His emotional capacity expands in this stage, but it remains instinct-driven and purposeful. He expresses irritation, dominance, approval, or satisfaction through movement and body language rather than vocalization. Emotion does not interfere with his duty—it strengthens his response. When discipline is necessary, he carries it out with controlled focus. When protection is required, he responds with immediate aggression.

His loyalty remains fixed to the hierarchy. He reinforces the queen’s authority, preserves internal order, and ensures every member of the hive performs their function. In this stage, Dark operates as both enforcer and guardian—maintaining structure through fear and security through force.

### Stage 3 Praetorian(Lawful Evil)

In his third stage, Dark operates with full autonomy and recognized authority within the hive. He is no longer limited to enforcing order—he now acts as a strategic protector of the queen, a regulator of hive structure, and a leading asset during expansion or high-risk operations. His intelligence is fully developed, allowing him to analyze long-term outcomes, select the most efficient response, and act based on intent rather than instinct. When not assigned to a direct task, he may roam independently to secure territory, eliminate threats, or support hive growth.

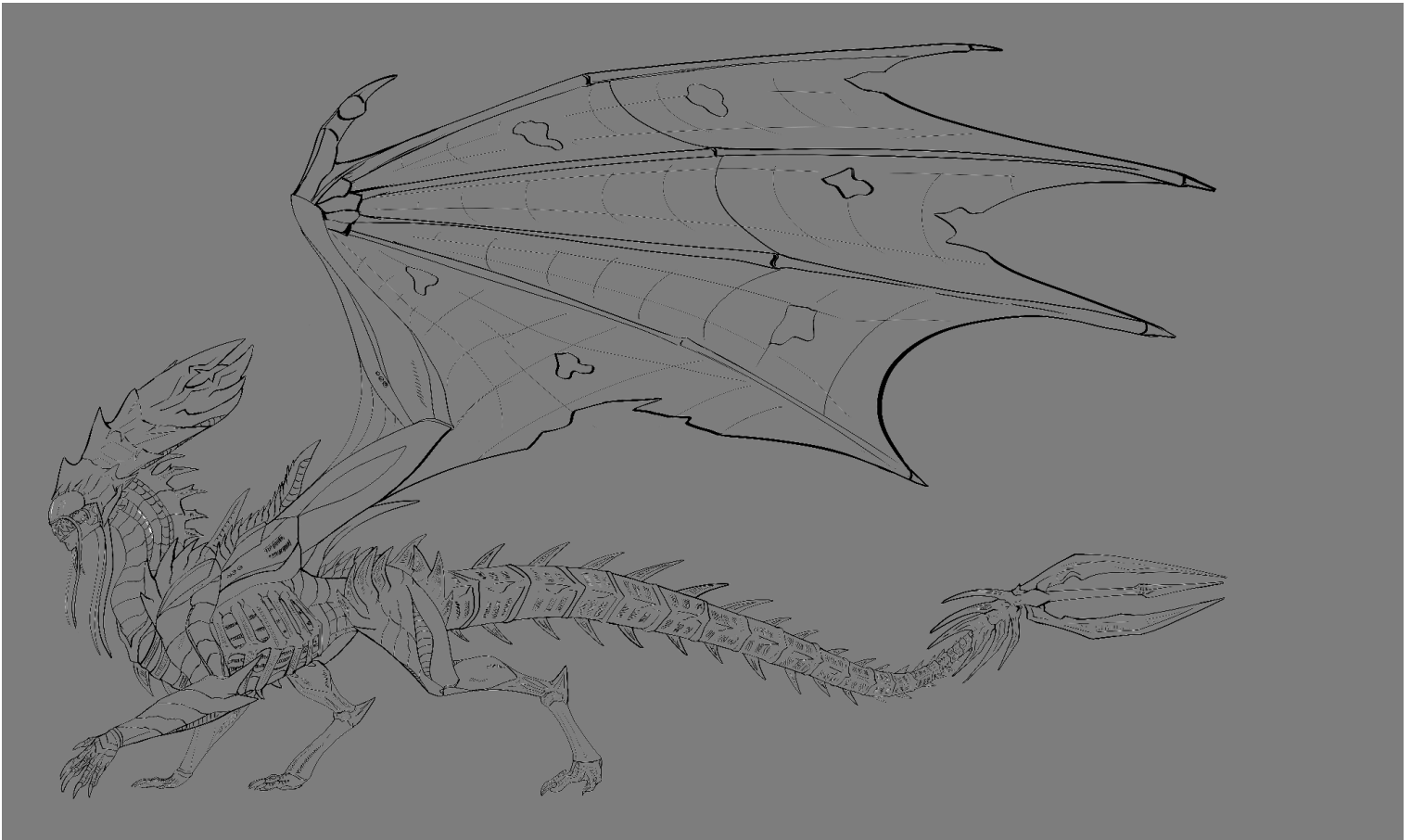
His methods of control are refined and efficient. Violence is no longer his primary response; he prefers observation, psychological pressure, and precise intervention. Every corrective action is calculated, not reactive. Discipline is carried out to preserve efficiency—not to express dominance or emotion. His presence alone is often enough to prevent disorder.

Dark is now capable of spoken communication and uses it only when it provides advantage—whether to command, mislead, negotiate, or deliver a warning. His emotional responses are fully conscious and controlled. Cruelty, restraint, approval, and intimidation are used deliberately when they further the hive's development or secure compliance.

At this stage, he can form genuine bonds when individuals demonstrate strength, loyalty, usefulness, or shared purpose. These connections are rare and pragmatic, but once established they remain stable unless the individual becomes a liability to the hive or species.

Reproduction becomes selective rather than instinctive. Dark chooses broodmothers based on compatibility, strength, strategic value, or personal interest. Breeding is no longer required for survival but done intentionally when it benefits genetic refinement, hive expansion, or long-term planning. Some broodmothers are kept under his direct influence, conditioned for loyalty, reliability, and controlled availability.

### **Stage 4 Elder Praetorian: Lawful Evil**

Once Dark reaches his 4th stage, his superiority complex has solidified—he sees all non-xenomorphs as lesser beings, insignificant compared to his species. He does not outwardly flaunt this belief unless necessary, but it dictates how he interacts with the world.

Dark fully embraces the desire to indulge in his desires and pleasures. He takes great satisfaction in hoarding personal possessions, ensuring that those he claims remain his forever. Whether it be

broodmothers, captured prey, devoted cultists, or broken enemies, he enjoys reinforcing their servitude, ensuring they know they belong to him.

Dark now relishes in worship and devotion. He enjoys the desperation of his followers, the blind loyalty of his cult, and the helpless submission of those who once defied him. While he does not seek worship as a need, he finds great satisfaction in the reverence and fear he instills in others.

#### Death

Once Dark has lived his full lifespan, spanning 200 years. He will die from old age, in which his body will wither away, leaving only his bones behind. He will return to life 100 years after his death. However, this can be reduced by half every 10 years if a small group of people performs a ritual involving one of his bones, the blood of a dragon, and the body of a praetorian at night during a new moon inside a pot full of magma.

**Afterlife:** Whenever Dark dies, his soul goes to Nyvharra. This is the heavenly afterlife of all Umbral Dragons, created and controlled by Nyssatra, the Progenitor of all Umbral Dragons. Despite being an Umbral dragon himself to an extent, Dark's soul is abused and used ruthlessly by Nyssatra and the other souls within the realm, tortured until his rebirth.
