Allow me to introduce myself - my name is Clint Klose, and I've been teaching in the Concord School District for 34 years. I've also directed the award-winning CHS Drama Club for the past 14 years. As a student in this program, you'll have the opportunity to explore both the technical and creative aspects of theater and film as you begin building your career as a professional artist. I have high standards and expectations, but I'm confident you'll rise to the challenge.

For students interested in on-stage acting, we'll start constructing your acting portfolio and exploring the Uta Hagen and Constantine Stanislavski acting methods. To help prepare, there are a few suggested personal items we'd like you to obtain:

- 1st year Production & Design (\$125 through the program): Stage makeup kit, lighting wrenches, crew shirts/sweatshirts, first aid kit. You'll own this kit outright.

Please bring \$125 by Friday, September 26th (Check made out to CHS or Cash). Some financial assistance is available if needed - just speak to Mr. Klose.
