

Privacy Policy for Outspark

Effective Date: July 11, 2026

1. Overview

Outspark is a Chrome Extension designed to reveal hidden, serendipitous facts on specific websites. We believe in strict data privacy. This policy outlines exactly how the extension operates and interacts with your browser.

2. Data Collection and Tracking

Outspark does not collect, store, or transmit your browsing history, personal data, or IP address to external servers.

3. How Outspark Works (Local Matching)

To function, Outspark requires the permission to read the current URL of the websites you visit (the `<all_urls>` permission). However, this data never leaves your computer.

When your browser opens, Outspark downloads a static, public list of target URLs from our database.

As you browse the web, Outspark performs all URL matching strictly locally on your machine to see if a serendipitous fact exists for your current page.

If a match is found, the fact is displayed. If no match is found, the extension remains dormant.

4. Third-Party Services

Outspark connects to a read-only Firebase Realtime Database solely to download the public catalog of serendipitous facts. It does not send any user-specific identifiers or browsing data to this database.
