5. Tempo – Did the speaker talk at the right speed, not too fast or too slow?
6. Pronunciation / Enunciation – Did the speaker say each word correctly and clearly?
7. Expression – Did the speaker have inflection and variety in his/her voice?
8. Poise – Did the speaker seem confident and relaxed?
9. Effect – Does the speech accomplish what it was intended to do (persuade, entertain, etc.)?
10. Impression – Does the speech make an impression on the audience?
